



Appeals by District in 2016








Cases by Docket Type in 2016




Wiretap Docket by Docketing District in 2016





Share of Published Decisions among Filed Decisions










Dispositions by Type in 2016




Number of Dispositions by Year







Median Number of Days to Disposition for Appeals Concluded in 2016




From Docket Date for all Appeals




Docket Date to Disposition by Order or Discontinuance




Docket Date to Disposition by Filed Decision



Certified Record Filing Date to Filed Decision








