# PETITION FOR RELIEF FOR LIFTING OF INTERIM SUSPENSION WITHOUT PAY

AND NOW, this 16<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2021, comes the Judicial Conduct Board of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (Board), by and through undersigned counsel, and files this Petition for Relief for Lifting of Interim Suspension Without Pay pursuant to Rule 701 of the Court of Judicial Discipline Rules of Procedure, and in support thereof, avers the following:

- From January 4, 2016, to the present, Respondent has served continuously as a Magisterial District Judge in Magisterial District 12-2-04, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania.
- 2. On February 8, 2021, the Board filed a Complaint in the Court of Judicial Discipline charging Respondent with violations of the Rules Governing Standards of Conduct of Magisterial District Judges (RGSCMDJ) and the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 3. On that same date, February 8, 2021, the Board filed a Petition for Relief for Interim Suspension Without Pay seeking Respondent's suspension based upon the following factual averments:

- a. On December 16, 2020, the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General (OAG) charged Respondent with Tampering with Evidence, 18 Pa.C.S.A. §4910, Obstructing Administration of Law, 18 Pa.C.S.A. §5101 and Official Oppression, 18 Pa.C.S.A. §5301, all second degree misdemeanor offenses.
- b. The Criminal Complaint alleged that Respondent took advantage of her position as a judge while at the scene of her son's traffic stop on February 22, 2020, thereby allowing her to "move freely about the scene of the traffic stop because of her position as a Magisterial District Judge."
- 4. By order dated February 9, 2021, the Honorable Court suspended Respondent without pay.
- 5. Following a Preliminary Hearing on February 19, 2021, the aforementioned criminal charges against Respondent were bound over to the Court of Common Pleas of Dauphin County, Pennsylvania.
- 6. On July 26, 2021, a jury was chosen and Respondent's criminal trial commenced.
- 7. On July 27, 2021, the prosecution rested its case and, on motion of the defendant, a judgment of acquittal on all three counts then pending against Respondent was granted.
- 8. The July 27, 2021 judgment of acquittal constituted a final disposition of the criminal charges against Respondent thereby eliminating the basis of the Board's request for the interim suspension of Respondent.

WHEREFORE, it is respectfully requested that this Honorable Court enter an order lifting its interim suspension order against Respondent.
