JURISDICTIONAL STATEMENT

Pursuant to Rules 909 and 910 of the Pennsylvania Rules of Appellate Procedure, Proposed Intervenor-Petitioners Haroon Bashir, Valerie Biancaniello, Tegwyn Hughes, and Jeffrey Wenk (collectively, the “Proposed Voter Intervenor”) submit this Jurisdictional Statement in support of their Notice of Appeal from the Commonwealth Court’s January 14, 2022 Order, which denied the Proposed Voter Intervenor’s Application for Leave to Intervene in these consolidated matters.

I. Opinion of the Court Below

The Proposed Voter Intervenor appeal from the Order entered by the Honorable Patricia A. McCullough of the Commonwealth Court on January 14, 2022 (the “Order”). A copy of the Order is attached as Exhibit A. The Court has not issued an opinion to accompany the Order.

II. Basis for Jurisdiction of the Supreme Court

Pursuant to Rule 1101(a)(1) of the Pennsylvania Rules of Appellate Procedure, an order of the Commonwealth Court entered in “any matter which was originally commenced in the Commonwealth Court and which does not constitute an appeal of the Commonwealth Court from another court, a district justice or another government unit” may be appealed as of right to the Supreme Court. Pa.R.A.P. 1101(a)(1). The Supreme Court has exclusive jurisdiction over such appeals. 42 Pa.C.S. § 723(a). Both of these consolidated matters were commenced

in the Commonwealth Court pursuant to its original jurisdiction. *See* 42 Pa.C.S. § 761(a)(1).

The Order denying the Proposed Voter Intervenor’s Application for Leave to Intervene is an immediately appealable collateral order because “the right involved is too important to be denied review and the question presented is such that if review is postponed until final judgment in the case, the claim will be irreparably lost.” Pa.R.A.P. 313. Under the Order, the Proposed Voter Intervenor has been denied:

- (1) the right to submit more than one proposed congressional map, Order ¶¶ 3, 5–6;
- (2) the right to submit a brief or expert report in response to the other maps submitted, Order ¶¶ 4–6;
- (3) the right to craft joint stipulations of fact, Order ¶ 10;
- and (4) the right to participate in the evidentiary hearing, including the offering of opening and closing statements, to present a witness, and the opportunity to cross-examine other witnesses, Order ¶¶ 11.

In light of the fact that the Legislative Redistricting Commission has issued two redistricting data sets, the Order’s restriction of the Proposed Voter Intervenor’s right to submit only one map is material. To the extent the Commonwealth Court determines one data set should be used and not the other, the Proposed Voter Intervenor may have no opportunity to submit a map using the data set the Commonwealth Court selects. Further, the Proposed Voter Intervenor will have no opportunity to defend their map at the evidentiary hearing. Nor will they have the

opportunity to critique the maps submitted by the other parties or cross-examine their witnesses. Thus, the Order treats the Proposed Voter Intervenor unequally with other voters of the Commonwealth, despite the fact that the Proposed Voter Intervenor represent the “mirror-image” of the Carter Petitioners.

The Proposed Voter Intervenor’s rights to full participation in this consolidated litigation is “too important to be denied review.” Pa.R.A.P. 313(b). “[I]f review is postponed until final judgment in this case,” the Proposed Voter Intervenor’s rights to fully participate in this litigation will be “irreparably lost.” *Id.*; *see also In re Barnes Found.*, 871 A.2d 792, 794 (Pa. 2005) (“a court’s order denying intervention is one type of order which must be appealed within thirty days of its entry under Rule of Appellate Procedure 903, or not at all, precisely because the failure to attain intervenor status forecloses a later appeal”).

III. Text of the Order in Question

This appeal seeks review of Paragraph 5 of the Order:

5. The Applications for Leave to Intervene as parties filed by (i) Voters of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, (ii) Citizen-Voters; (iii) Draw the Lines-PA; and (iv) Khalif Ali et al. are **DENIED**.

Voters of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Citizen-Voters, Draw the Lines-PA, and Khalif Ali et al., are permitted to participate in these matters as Amicus Participants, which means that their participation shall be limited to submissions to the Court **in writing** as set forth in Paragraph 6 of this Order.

IV. Concise Statement of Procedural History

On December 17, 2021, the Carter Petitioners and the Gressman Petitioners—individuals registered to vote in Pennsylvania—each filed a Petition Review in the Commonwealth Court pursuant to its original jurisdiction. On December 20, 2021, the Commonwealth Court consolidated the two actions. Also on December 20, the Commonwealth Court set a deadline of December 31, 2021 for applications to intervene to be filed. The Proposed Voter Intervenor timely filed an application for leave to intervene on December 31. A total of 10 groups of proposed intervenors sought leave to intervene. The parties to the action filed timely responses. The Commonwealth Court held a hearing on all of the applications for leave to intervene on January 6, in which the Proposed Voter Intervenor participated.

On January 14, 2022, the Commonwealth Court entered the Order, denying the Proposed Voter Intervenor’s Application for Leave to Intervene. In that same Order, the Commonwealth Court denied all other applications for leave to intervene filed by individual voters. Also in the Order, the Commonwealth Court granted the applications to intervene filed by currently elected officeholders.

V. Question Presented for Review

Whether the Commonwealth Court erred by denying the Proposed Voter Intervenor’s Application for Leave to Intervene?

ANSWER: Yes.

The hearing will begin at 9:30 a.m. in Courtroom 3001 of the Pennsylvania Judicial Center, Harrisburg, PA. It shall be the responsibility of Petitioners to secure the services of a court reporter(s)

throughout the duration of the hearing. Each Party is limited to presenting one witness at the hearing, who shall be subject to cross examination by the other Parties. Opening and closing statements and argument by Parties shall be permitted. The Court will also consider revisions to the 2022 election schedule/calendar as part of the hearing.

12.If the General Assembly has not produced a new congressional map by January 30, 2022, the Court shall proceed to issue an opinion based on the hearing and evidence presented by the Parties.
