GRADING CODES MODIFIED

In order to provide accurate and complete court case disposition records to the Pennsylvania State Police's (PSP) Computer Criminal History Record Information (CCHRI) system, a couple of grading codes have been modified. Grading codes of MU and FM have been removed and replaced with H1 and H2 for murder of the first and second degree. You will now see H1 and H2 in the pop-up window when pressing F4 on the Grade field on the Grading Results screen and the Final Chare Entry screen.

In addition, several other grading code changes have been made. In order to fully provide for all summary grades as allowed under the Game and Wildlife code, as well as the Fish and Boat Code, summary grading codes have been added and now include S, S1, S2, S3, S4, S5, S6, S7, and S8. Furthermore, the Offense/Grade field on the Local Ordinance Maintenance screen is now limited to just the summary set of grades.

INTERESTED PARTY NAME FORMATTING

Please avoid typing special characters in the Last and First Name fields of defendants. Special characters may cause issues when case dispositions are transmitted to PSP, and therefore, will require manual intervention. For example, use of parentheses, asterisks, or numeric characters in name fields will be rejected when the case disposition is reported to PSP. Also, if you need to record an inmate number to associate to an interested party name, record this on an address line rather than in a name field. Thank you for your attention and cooperation.
