## **Campaign Spending a Focus; Supreme Court's Special Campaign Schedules Public Hearing in Philadelphia**

**PHILADELPHIA, February 2, 1998** - The Pennsylvania Supreme Court's Special Commission to Limit Judicial Campaign Expenditures has scheduled a public hearing here on Friday, February 6, at 10 a.m. The hearing will be held in the Commonwealth Court's Courtroom No. 1 on the ninth floor of the Widener Building at One South Penn Square.

The commission is charged with studying all facets of the state's judicial campaigns, but the major focus is on determining how to limit expenditures.

Announcement of the public hearing was made by Commission Chair James F. Mundy, of Philadelphia, immediate past president of the Pennsylvania Bar Association.
