\* The eight verdicts for over five million dollars are against Charles Cullen, a former Registered Nurse who pled guilty in 2004 to murdering numerous patients. These 8 civil cases were brought by the estates of patients against Cullen and the medical facilities that employed him. The medical facilities were dismissed from the cases on summary judgment, and the trial proceeded solely against Cullen who did not defend the matter.
