### **NOTICE Death Penalty Cases**

Effective immediately, the Pennsylvania Supreme Court, under Rule 2189 of the PA Rules of Appellate Procedure, will no longer require the filing of eight (8) copies of the entire record.

Pursuant to Pa.R.A.P 105 the Court will now require four (4) copies of the record be reproduced and filed with the Office of the Prothonotary of the Supreme Court, Eastern District. Furthermore, the record shall also be electronically transmitted on a CD in PDF format if the technology is available.
