F72 – NEW FINE TYPE

Fine type F72 has been added to the MDJS to implement provisions of Act 27 of 2008 relating to the clean air laws. This fine type disburses the fine money to the Department of Revenue, County, or Local Municipality based on the filing officer type. The fine type is associated with new statute entries under Sections 637.3, 637.4 and 637.6, and 637.7 of Title 35. This Act also repeals the prior clean indoor air statute of 35 P.S. 1230.1.

NCIC COMPLIANT VEHICLE TYPE CODES

As a reminder, beginning November 18, 2008, the “Make” and “Type” fields on the Traffic Case Entry screen will contain F4 code lists that comply with the NCIC vehicle codes. When this change is implemented, the MDJS will no longer permit the entry of legacy vehicle codes in the “Make” and “Type” fields. Informational laser fax 5.106 on August 12th first notified you of this change.

Please review the documents available on the Statewide folder. It defines the old “Legacy Codes” and the new “NCIC Codes”. Remember only the codes in the “NCIC Codes” column can be entered into the MDJS once this change is implemented. Please share this information with local law enforcement in an effort to ensure police officers are recording the NCIC vehicle codes on citations filed in your court after November 17th.

To view the documents in the statewide folder:

- ? From the Desktop, double-click the computer icon located in the upper left corner of the screen. The Network Drives window appears.
- ? Double-click the statewide network drive.
- ? Double-click on the folder labeled “NCIC CODES.”
- ? Double-click the documents labeled “Make” and “Type.” (Caution: do not print “Type” because it is 100 pages.)
