Rules for Jan. 23 Supreme Court redistricting hearing

HARRISBURG – Reporters who cover the Jan. 23 Supreme Court’s oral argument session on the state legislative redistricting plan are reminded that the Supreme Court does not allow transmission of data from its courtrooms and no cell phones, laptops or other electronic devices are allowed in the chamber.

Anyone bringing this equipment must check it at the Prothonotary’s Office outside the courtroom.

The Pennsylvania Cable Network (PCN) will be televising the proceeding live. It is the first time a Supreme Court proceeding will be televised live other than for ceremonial proceedings.

The hearing will begin at 9:30 a.m. in the Supreme Court’s Harrisburg courtroom on the 4th floor of the Pennsylvania Capitol. A [schedule](#) for the appeals has been set. Observers will be admitted on a first-come-first-served basis. Once the courtroom is full, those not admitted may wait in line to take a seat as those who were seated leave.
