INTERESTED PARTY UPDATES

AOPC is now using the PSP arrest message to populate defendant information that is not recorded on the interested party screen. The fields are SID, Gender, Race, Height, Weight, Eye Color, Hair Color, Birth Date, Place of Birth, Social Security Number and FBI Number. In addition, the name on the PSP message will be added as an alias to the docketed case. If the arrest message has conflicting data with the MDJS, an update will not occur. For example, if the interested party has a recorded eye color of blue in the MDJS, but the PSP arrest message contains an eye color of brown, an update on the MDJS will not occur. Only fields without values will be updated if the message provides the data. A large interested party update occurred a couple of days ago, but daily updates will now transpire. Updating a defendant's record in this manner will provide electronic exchange partners with up-to-date and accurate defendant information.
