ISSUING MULTIPLE SUBPOENAS

As a result of user suggestions since June 25th, the MDJS subpoena process has been further streamlined. Issuing multiple subpoenas from the same case has been made easier because certain information recorded for the first interested party being subpoenaed will now be copied to the other interested parties being subpoenaed.

For example, when selecting more than one interested party to be subpoenaed, the MDJS will only require you to complete information in the "Requested By," "On Behalf Of," and "Mail" fields once, rather than for each interested party being subpoenaed. Additionally, if you select HAND as the Mail code, the recorded server will carry over to all interested parties being subpoenaed.

Be aware that if you are recording information for a subpoena that is different among the interested parties (for example, multiple constables are serving the subpoenas), you must then issue the subpoenas separately.
