WARRANT PROCESSING

Several improvements, as described below, have been made to MDJS warrant processing.

- ? Warrant issue and cancel codes that display on the Warrant Entry screen have been separated and will display based on the selected warrant action code. In addition, warrant issue reasons will be specific to case type. For example, when issuing a warrant for a traffic case, only reason codes applicable to a summary case will display and will be allowed. The following tables outline the set of codes and associations.

Issue Reasons

Criminal Court Case

CRCT- Criminal Contempt
IDUK- Identity Unknown
WNOS- Defendant Won't Obey a Summons
FLNY- Felony
SADO- Summons Disobeyed
SUND- Summons Undelivered
PTPH- Threat to Self/Other
OTAW- Other (Arrest Warrant)
OTBW – Other (Bench Warrant)
FLRA- Failure to Appear
VLRC- Violated Release Conditions

Summary Case

SUND- Summons Undelivered
WNOS - Defendant Won't Obey a Summons
FLRA - Failure to Appear
FLRS - Failure to Respond
FLPY - Failure to Pay
FLRP - Failure to Make a Payment

- ? The collateral amount pop-up question on the Warrant Entry screen will no longer appear for criminal court cases and arraignment for other court cases.
- ? Reason text that is recorded for reason codes OTAW (Other Arrest Warrant) and OTBW (Other Bench Warrant) will display in docket inquiry.
- ? The warrant control number will now print on the second page of arrest and bench warrant forms.
- ? Language on criminal court case warrants has been modified to state, "When the defendant is taken into custody, bring the defendant before me at the court address shown above to answer the complaint of _____."

The statement on summary warrants now reads, "When the defendant is taken into custody, bring the defendant before me at the court address shown above to answer the complaint or citation of _____."

If the offense is a statute, the name of the arresting agency will print in the blank space. If the offense is a local ordinance, the name of the municipal corporation will instead print.
