

On behalf of Senator Joseph B. Scarnati, III, Senator Jake Corman, and the Senate Republican Caucus (collectively, "the Senators"), this letter is to advise that the Senators will not be filing an answer to Petitioner's Application for the Court to Exercise Jurisdiction Pursuant to its King's Bench Powers and/or Powers to Grant Extraordinary Relief, in so far as the Application seeks to invoke this Court's jurisdiction. In terms of the merits of the Application, the Senators, as noted by Petitioner, see Appl. at 13 n.14, have already filed a substantive brief in the Commonwealth Court, see Scarnati v. Wolf, No. 344 MD 2020, and the Senators rely on the same to the extent the Court is looking for a response on the merits.
