 should not be extended in any way, as such an extension would be contrary to the plain text
 of the Election Code.
- 2. Respondents hereby join the arguments of the Pennsylvania Republican Party and of Respondent Kathy Boockvar with respect to the Pennsylvania Democratic Party's request for a declaratory judgment that County Boards of Elections must contact voters whose mailin ballots contain minor errors. This request has no basis in the actual text of the Election Code.

 to the Secretary's request that so-called "naked ballots" be deemed valid under the Election
 Code.
