Dear Mr. Mittleman:

Considering the request made by Chief Justice Castile and having examined the packet of information my Court Administrator and I received from your office, we concluded that we should reduce the number of MDJ offices in our county by one or two. Those reductions would bring the caseloads and workloads into close parity with other fourth class counties.

We have two MDJs who plan to retire at the end of 2013 which makes our job easier in some respects, but examining those districts, and trying to follow the Chief's directives as to how to achieve this reduction presented some difficulty. As well as trying to make changes by attrition, and insuring that sitting MDJs live and maintain an office in their realigned district, we had to take into account the convenience of residents and police departments contained within those districts. Specifically, in addition to other considerations, we tried to avoid having police departments file at more than one MDJ office, if at all possible, and we attempted to limit to one half hour the time a resident of a district would have to travel to a MDJ office. In addition, one of the districts we could realign by attrition is a quite busy office and is the most rapidly growing municipality within our county. Were we to start from scratch, we would not elect to significantly change that district.

Nonetheless, although our plan to reduce and realign districts may not be ideal, to make meaningful changes in any other way would require a total realignment of districts. As we looked at other possibilities that would reduce two districts and even the workload from one MDJ to another within the county, those plans leave districts where MDJs plan to retire intact, but would pit existing MDJs against one another in at least two other districts. Thus, we would be effecting the reductions not by attrition, but by contested elections. The net effect would be four new faces in the eight offices replacing two MDJs who choose to retire and two who would be voted out.

The plan we now submit leaves us with eight of our current ten MDJs. Each MDJ lives within his or her realigned district, and although we plan to move several offices so they will be centrally located, the current offices are now within the realigned district, and the same directive will be followed as we relocate offices. The workload that each MDJ will carry is fairly even across the county and is in fair parity with other 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> class counties. Finally, we believe our plan will cause as little disruption as can be accomplished. The MDJs retain as much of their original district as is possible, thus causing the minimum change for residents, police departments and municipalities.

As we formulated our plan, we publicized our intentions through all media sources within the county and then traveled to each MDJ office for public meetings. We advertised these well in advance and most meetings were well attended. Very little opposition was expressed at those meetings. Further, we published the fact that our plan was posted on our county website and was available for physical inspection in our courthouse and at each MDJ office as well. We further advised that public comments could be made until March 31<sup>st</sup> and submitted either to a county email address or in writing. To my knowledge, no response was received.
