PER CURIAM

AND NOW, this 2nd day of August, 2018, the Honorable John M. Cleland, as the

special master in these appeals assigned to oversee the preparation of an interim grand

jury report, is also designated to address and resolve the petitioners' objections to the

redacted briefs submitted by Office of Attorney General in the above-captioned matters.

In considering those objections, Judge Cleland is to determine whether the

challenged passages constitute specific or contextual references particular to the

petitioners, which could allow for a discernment of their identity. Those passages are to

be redacted from the briefs. As one point of specific direction, initials should not be

substituted for names, since this approach could suggest an association between

allegations of misconduct and a case caption employing a petitioner's initials, thus

potentially giving rise to public speculation concerning identity.

Judge Cleland shall transmit the amended version of the redacted briefs to this

Court as soon as practicable. In keeping with this Court's July 6 directive, the parties are

cautioned against instigating unnecessary ancillary litigation regarding the production of

redacted versions of the briefs.
