Rule 101. Purpose, Application, and Construction of Rules.

- [(A)](a) <u>Purpose.</u> These rules are intended to provide for the just determination of every delinquency proceeding <u>and effectuate the purposes stated</u> in the Juvenile Act, 42 Pa.C.S. § 6301(b).
- [(B)](b) <u>Application.</u> These rules establish uniform practice and procedure for courts exercising jurisdiction as provided in the Juvenile Act, 42 Pa.C.S. §§ 6301 *et seq.*, and shall be [construed] <u>applied</u> to secure uniformity and simplicity in procedure, fairness in administration, and the elimination of unjustifiable expense and delay.
- [(C) These rules shall be interpreted and construed to effectuate the purposes stated in the Juvenile Act, 42 Pa.C.S. § 6301(b).
- (D) To the extent practicable, these rules shall be construed in consonance with the rules of statutory construction.]
- (c) <u>Construction. In the construction of the Pennsylvania Rules of</u> <u>Juvenile Court Procedure, the principles set forth in Pa.R.J.A. 104</u> to 115 shall be observed.

- (c) <u>Construction. In the construction of Pennsylvania Rules of</u> <u>Juvenile Court Procedure, the principles set forth in Pa.R.J.A. 104</u> to 115 shall be observed.
