York County Judicial Center Court Employees Test Positive for COVID-19

HARRISBURG – York County Court Administration today announced that two judicial center court employees tested positive for COVID-19.

Neither employee has been inside the judicial center for the past two weeks. Prior to that, as required they both adhered to health and safety guidelines including the use of personal protective equipment and social distancing when interacting with coworkers and the public.

Those potentially exposed, as defined by the Centers for Disease Control, will be notified by public health officials. While contact tracing efforts have just started, at this time there is no indication the public was exposed to the affected employees.
