Evers selected interim court administrator for the First Judicial District

HARRISBURG – The Pennsylvania Supreme Court has approved the recommendation of the First Judicial District’s (FJD) Administrative Governing Board to appoint Joseph H. Evers as the interim court administrator of the FJD until a full-time replacement is hired.

Evers, 58, of Philadelphia, is a 40-year veteran of the Philadelphia court system. He was appointed prothonotary for the FJD in 1995 and has also served as clerk of courts since 2010. Before becoming prothonotary he was a deputy prothonotary, the data processing coordinator for the Office of Prothonotary and assistant supervisor and data entry clerk in the civil division of the Common Pleas and Municipal Court.

Evers will continue to serve as the FJD prothonotary and clerk of courts in addition to his duties as court administrator.

Evers will replace district court administrator David D. Wasson who is resigning effective April 19 to join the city of Philadelphia’s Office of Innovation and Technology.
