Court 101: Common court terms you may not know

Court 101: Common court terms you may not know	
ľ	CLERK OF COURTS The official in each country (inespective of formal title) who has responsibility to keep and maintain criminal case records of the Court of Common Pieas. The person may be elected or appointed depending on the jurisdiction.
	PROTHONOTARY The official in each county (irrespective of formal title) who has responsibility to keep and maintain most civil case records of the Court of Common Pleas. In some counties one official may serve the functions of both the clerk of courts and the prothonotary. The person may be elected by votes or appointed by the court or another elected official.
