Modification of Rules Related to Execution of Bench Warrants

AND NOW this 20<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2020, due to the continuing COVID-19 threat and in an effort to reduce exposure and transmission of the virus at the Greene County Prison:

This Court ORDERS the following:

Greene County Magisterial District Judges shall not incarcerate any defendant for failure to pay fines and costs.

No defendant shall be incarcerated on any existing District Court bench warrant that has been issued for failure to pay fines and costs.

No defendant shall be incarcerated for any bench warrant issued by the Greene County Court of Common Pleas that has been issued for failure to make payment by the Greene County Court of Common Pleas.


This order shall remain until February 1, 2021 pending further order of this Court.

A copy of this order shall be provided to the Greene County District Attorney, the District Courts, and disseminated to all law enforcement agencies.


