ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

AND NOW, this 7th day of December, 2020, in light of the rapid and uncontrolled spread of the COVID-19 virus, it is hereby **ORDERED** and **DECREED** that all court proceedings in the 9th Judicial District involving prisoners shall be conducted by video until further order of this court. If a prisoner does not consent to conduct the proceeding by video, it shall be continued. The resulting delay will be attributed to the Cumberland County Judiciary and shall be presumptively excluded from the calculation of time for the purposes of Pa.R.Crim.P. 600. *See, Commonwealth v. Crowley*, 466 A.2d 1009 (Pa. 1983).

The Cumberland County Sheriff and deputies, and law enforcement officers, including the Pennsylvania State Police as well as Constable, are to decline transportation from any prison/jail to any court office in this district despite a valid transportation order.
