ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER


AND NOW, this 18th day of March, 2020, in light of public health advisories regarding Coronavirus (COVID-19), in order to limit the risk of exposure and spreading of the virus, and in an effort to protect the health of children and families, it is hereby ORDERED and DECREED as follows:

All visitation by Court Order and/or pursuant to Pennsylvania Code Sections 3130.68 and 3490.235 between an adjudicated dependent youth in placement and his/her parent, legal guardian, sibling or prospective placement resource; Guardians *ad Litem*; and Mifflin County Children and Youth Social Services Agency staff shall be done by a method of telecommuting. Telecommuting shall include video conference, Skype, telephone calls and any other means of video or audio communication designed to effectuate meaningful and effective visitation and/or contact.

Mifflin County Children and Youth Social Services Agency shall make all reasonable efforts to carry out telecommuting visitation and contacts, mindful of the evolving public health advisories concerning COVID-19.

This Order shall remain in effect until further Administrative Order of Court.
