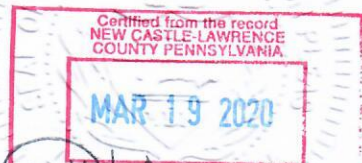
This order is effective immediately and shall continue in effect during the entire period of declaration of judicial emergency.
