**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**


AND NOW, March 31, 2020, upon consideration of the ongoing state of emergency due to COVID-19, the March 19, 2020 Administrative Order closing the Courthouse to the public and closing the courts to the public except for essential functions and other proceedings that may be handled through advanced communication technology is hereby EXTENDED to the close of business on April 14, 2020 or until further order of the Pennsylvania Supreme Court or the President Judge of this Court.

Within 24 hours of this order, notice of this action shall be provided by this court via the District Court Administrator as follows:

- A. Provided to the Administrative Office of Pennsylvania Courts;
- B. Posted on the entry doors of the county courthouse of the Judicial District and all Magisterial District Courts within the Judicial District.
- C. Posted on the Judicial District's website; and

D. Transmitted via e-mail to the local county bar association with the request that such association promptly forward the notice to all members.
