
ORDER

AND NOW, April 6, 2020 the order of March 18, 2020 suspending visitation between parents and children in care of Clarion County Children and Youth Services due to COVID-19, was effective for the period of March 19 through March 31, 2020, which suspension of visitation was extended through April 14, 2020 by the order of March 26, 2020.

With the April 1, 2020 Order of the Supreme Court extending the statewide judicial emergency through April 30, 2020, the suspension of visitation between parents and children in care of Clarion County Children and Youth Services is once again extended and shall remain in effect through April 30, 2020.

Clarion County Children and Youth Services, at their discretion and when able to do so, may arrange contact via telephone and/or video conference. However, they are not required to do so.
