AND NOW, this '50' day of April, 2020, pursuant to the Supreme Court's April 28, 2020 "Emergency Order of Statewide Judicial Administration Applicable from May 1, 2020, through June 1, 2020," Bucks County Emergency Order No. 2020-13 is hereby amended as follows:

III. Suspension of Time Calculation

All time calculations for purposes of time computation relevant to court cases or other judicial business, as well as time deadlines, are SUSPENDED through May 8, 2020, subject to further order of the Supreme Court. Any legal papers or pleadings (other than commencement of actions where the statute of limitations may be in issue) which are required to be filed between March 19, 2020, and May 8, 2020, generally SHALL BE DEEMED to have been timely filed if they are filed by close of business on May 11, 2020.
