**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**

AND NOW, this <sup>14<sup>th</sup></sup> day of May, 2020, it is hereby **ORDERED** and **DECREED** that all temporary orders for protection from abuse that were scheduled for a final hearing between March 18, 2020 and May 1, 2020 but were cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic, and any temporary order issued between March 16, 2020 and the date of this order **SHALL EXPIRE** on July 1, 2020, if not otherwise specifically extended by a subsequent court order or superseded by a final protection from abuse order.

This order shall constitute an affirmative defense to any violations of said temporary orders alleged to have occurred after July 1, 2020.
