AMENDMENT TO OMNIBUS ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

AND NOW, this 23rd day of June, 2020, pursuant to the Supreme Court’s Order of May 27, 2020 (Nos. 531 and 532 Judicial Administration Docket), and the judicial emergency declared in the 20th Judicial District of Pennsylvania on March 16, 2020, currently extended through August 31, 2020, the Court issues this Amendment to Omnibus Administrative Order, amending the following sections of its Omnibus Administrative Order issued under the above docket numbers on June 19, 2020.

1. Section V.A.2, regarding Magisterial District Court Operations, is amended to read as follows:

Central Court will resume in July 2020, with the timing and Magistrate District Judge rotation to be determined by Court Administration. Waiver hearings for defendants waiving their right to a preliminary hearing will occur each Tuesday, and preliminary hearings will occur each Wednesday. Scheduling will be done by Court Administration. All Central Court proceedings will be conducted via ACT. Magisterial District Judges will conduct Central Court proceedings from their respective court facilities, rather than traveling to the Bailey Building.

2. Section VI.A.2, regarding Protection From Abuse Orders, is amended to correct the e-mail address for filings with the Prothonotary, which is prothonotary-orders@huntingdoncounty.net.
