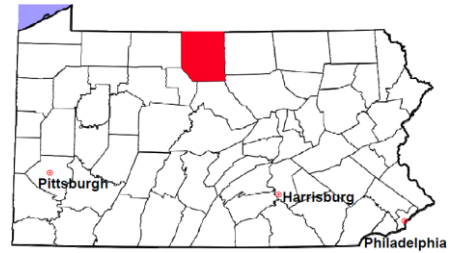

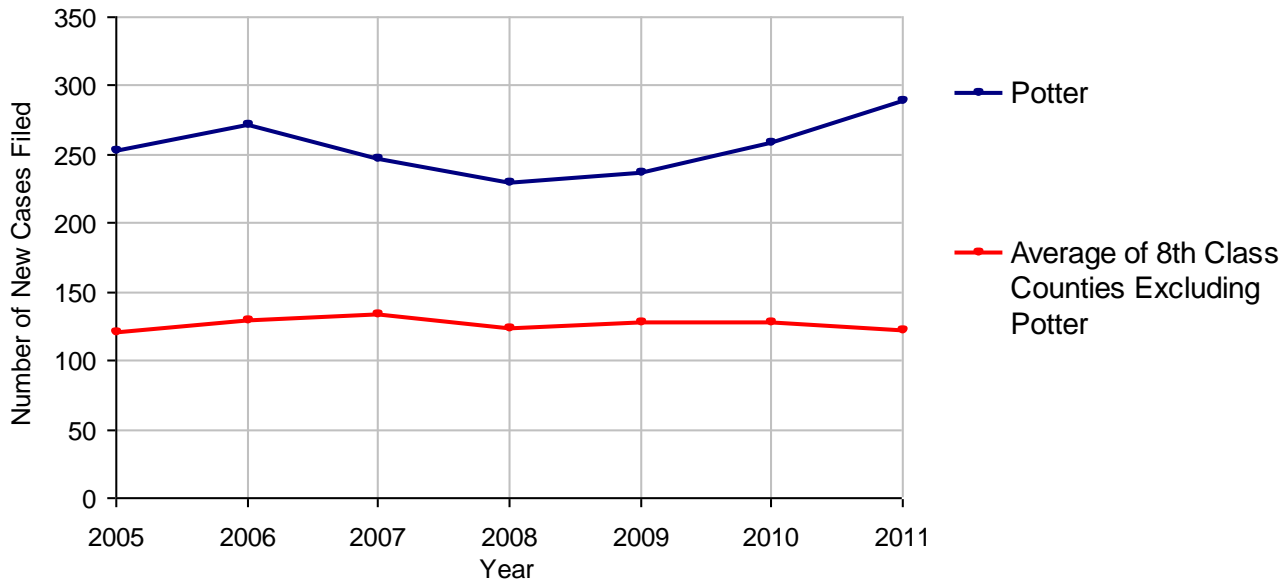

**Criminal New Cases Filed, 2005-2011**

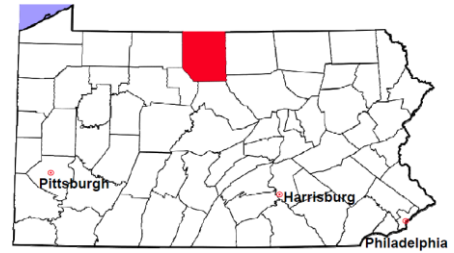

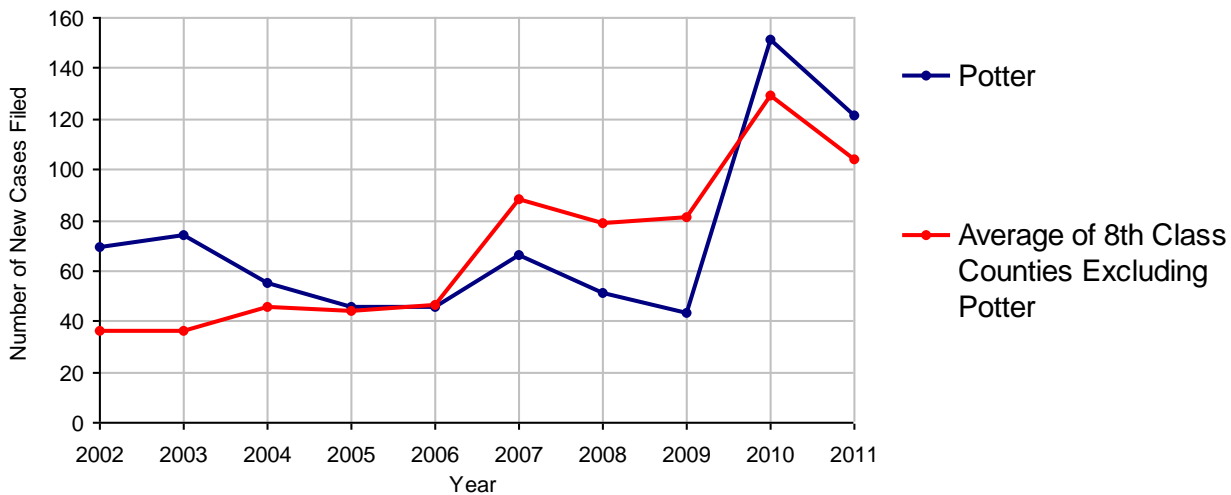

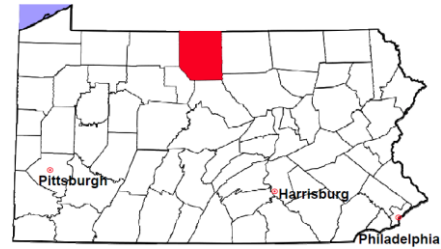
Docketed Cases, 2002-2011

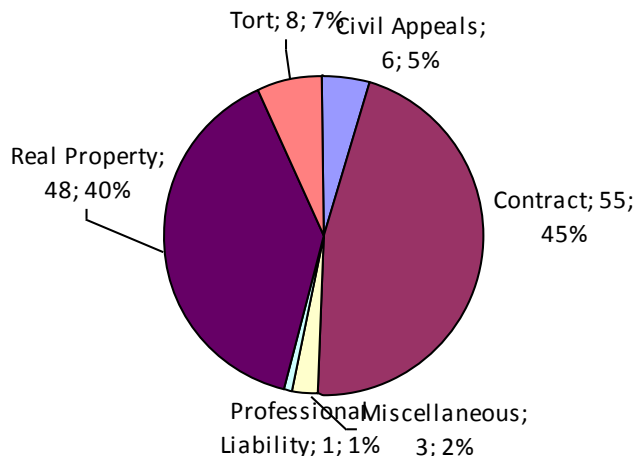

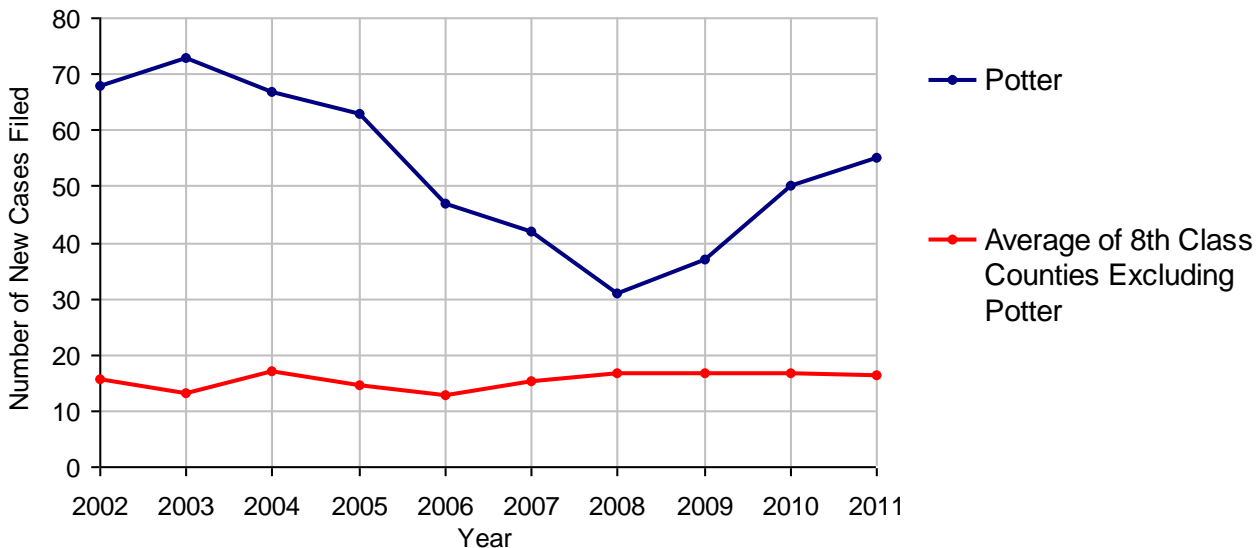

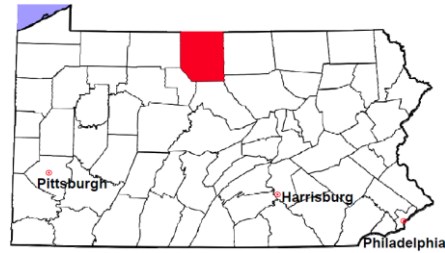

**PFA New Cases Filed, 2002-2011**

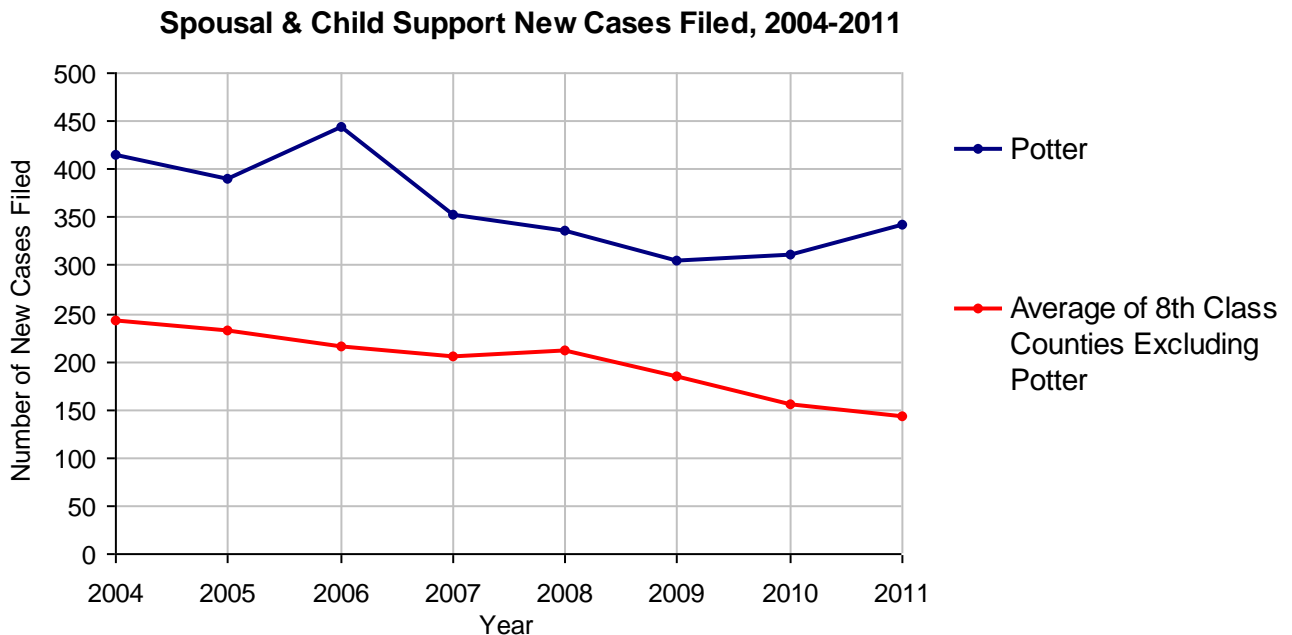

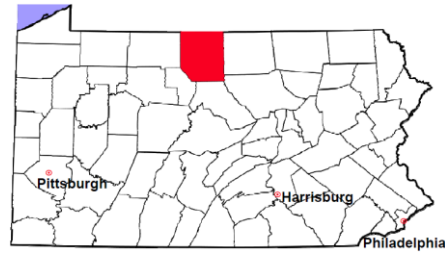

**Divorce New Cases Filed, 2002-2011**

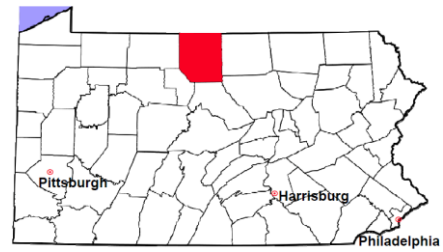

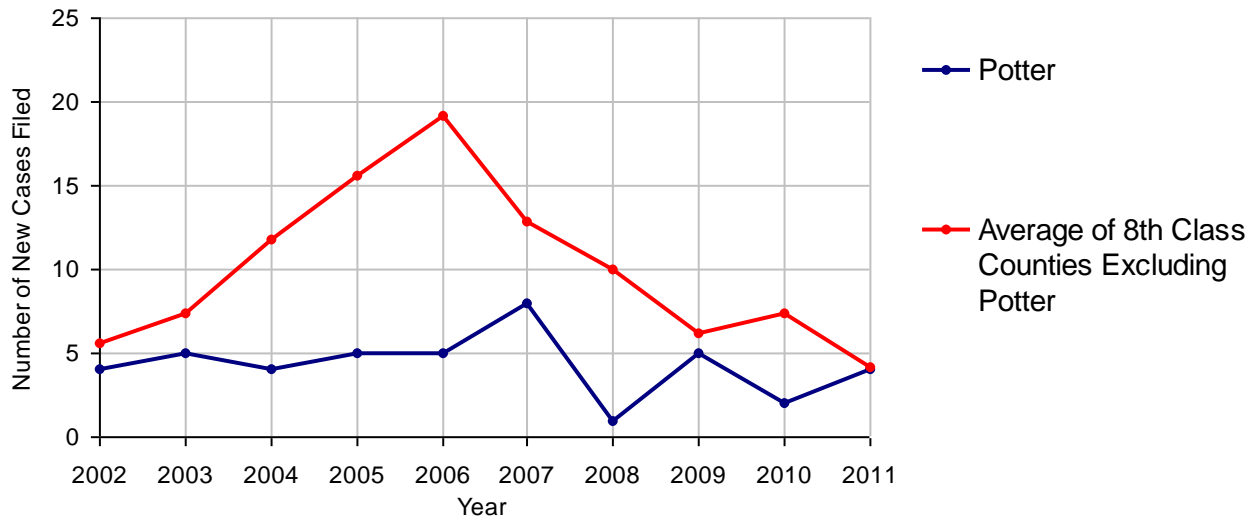

Abuse/Neglect and Status Offenses New Cases Filed, 2002-2011



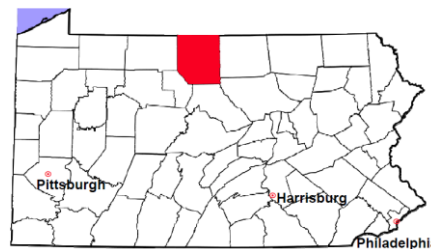

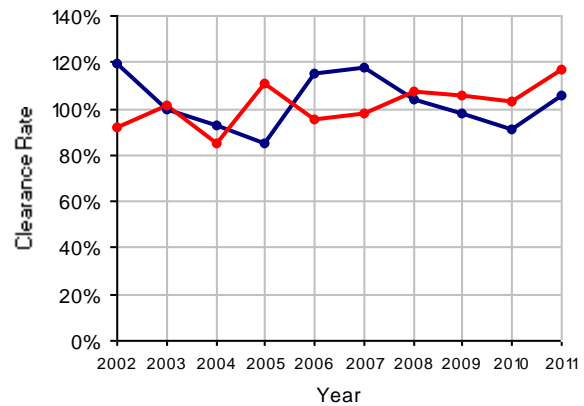

Juvenile Delinquency New Cases Filed, 2002-2011

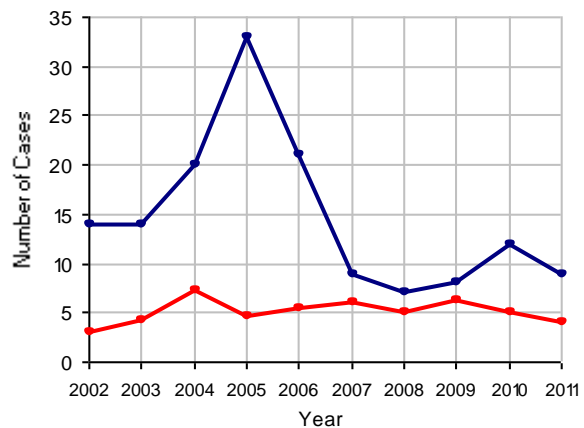


Clearance Rate, 2002-2011



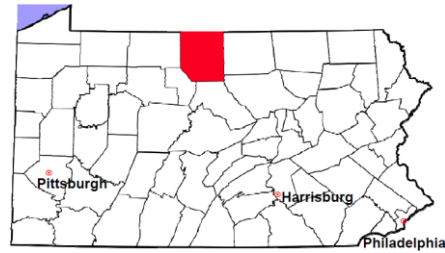

Cases Pending at the End of Year, 2002-2011



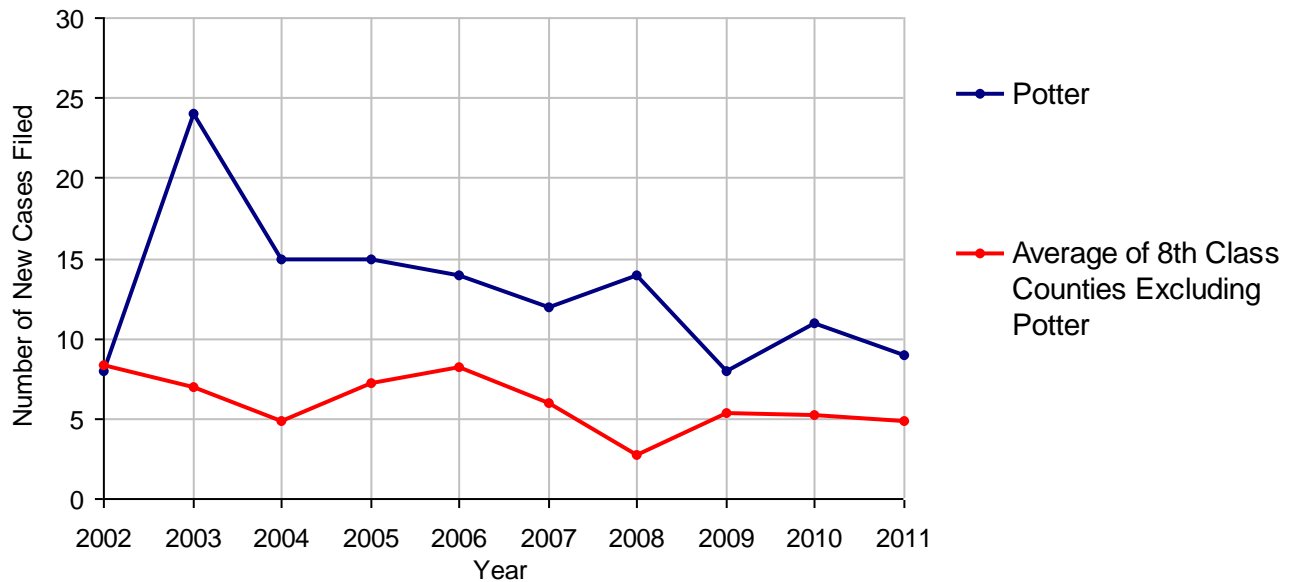

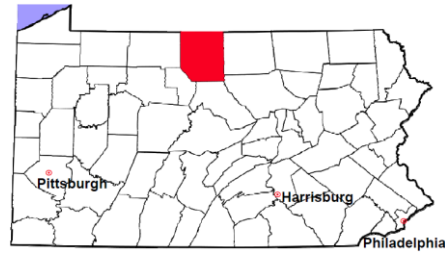

**Accounts New Cases Filed, 2002-2011**



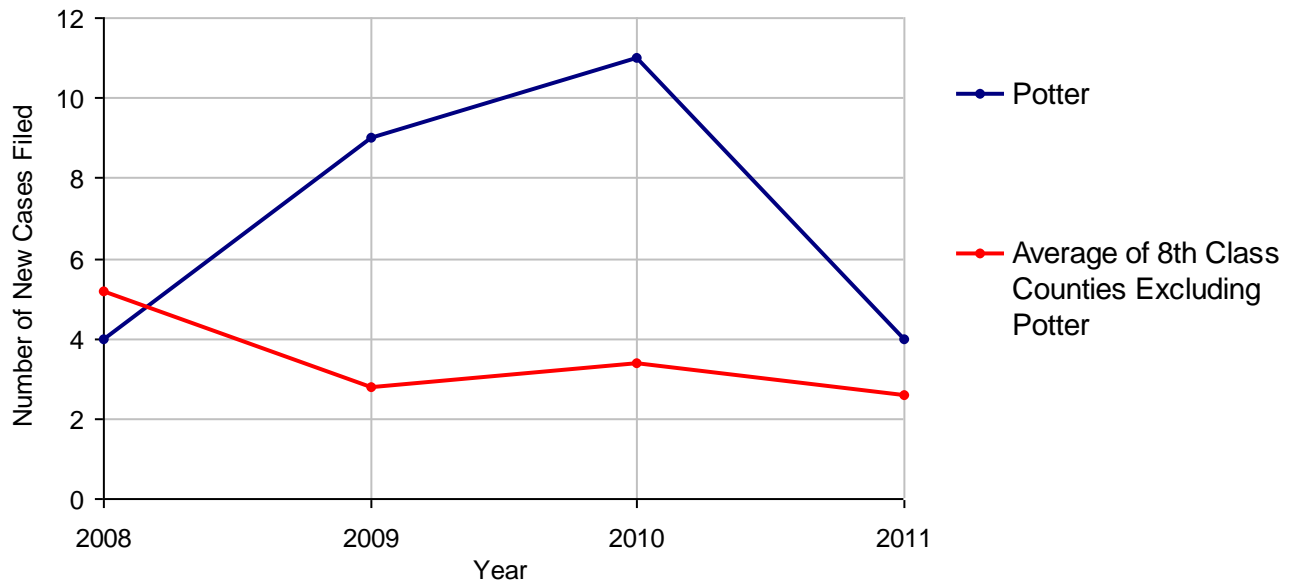

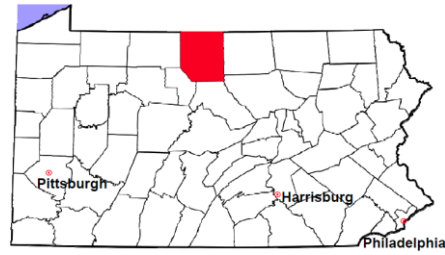
**Adoptions New Cases Filed, 2008-2011**

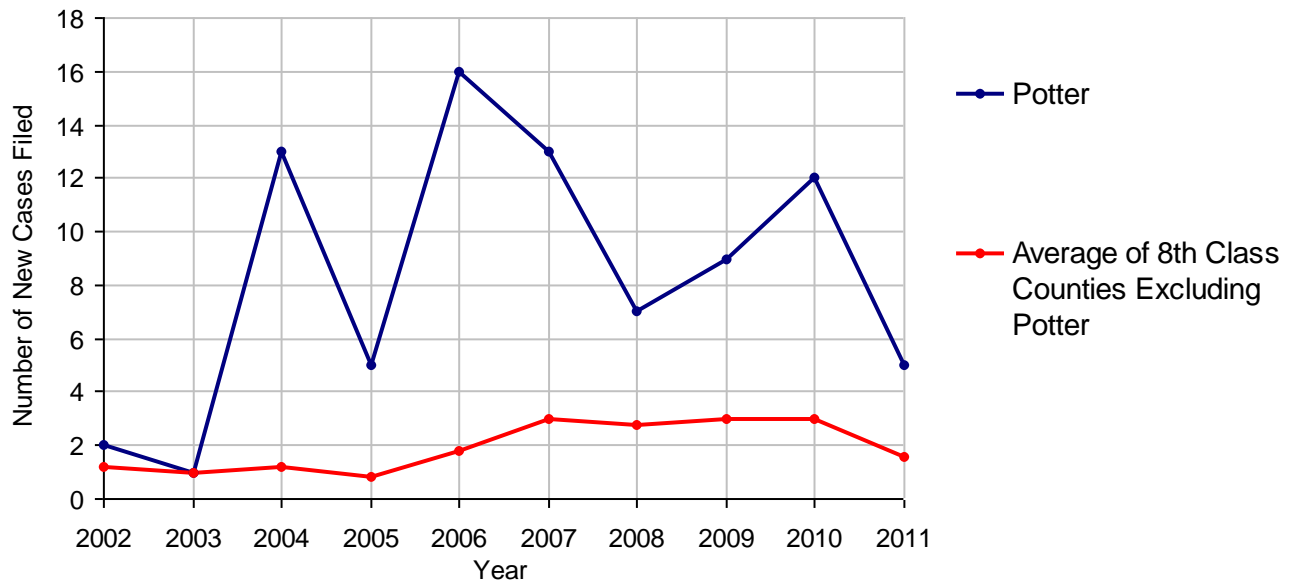

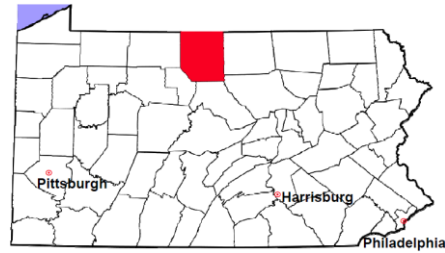

**Relinquishments/Terminations New Cases Filed, 2002-2011**



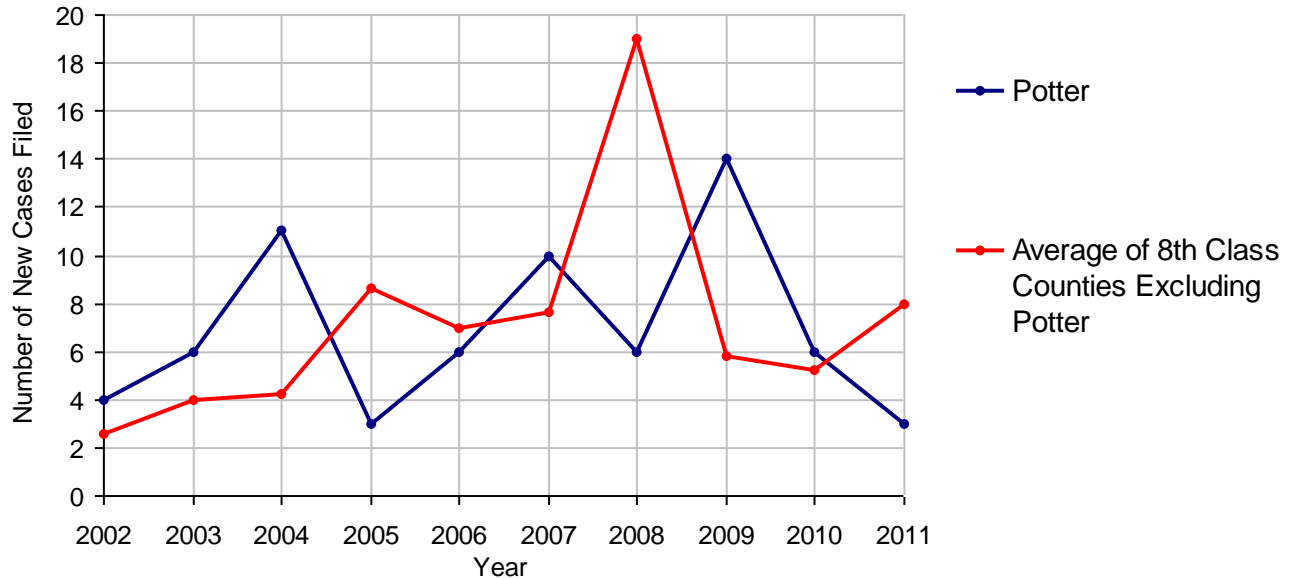

**Appointment of Guardians New Cases Filed, 2002-2011**

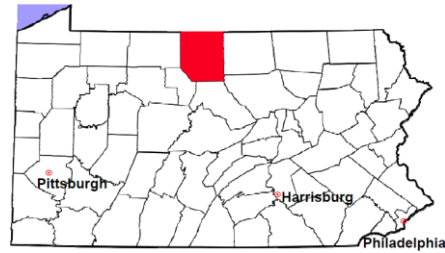
