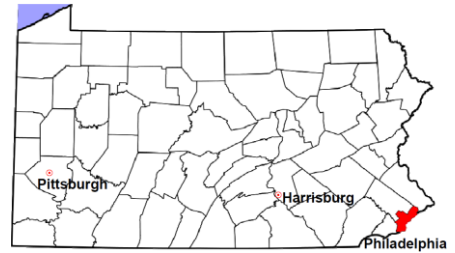

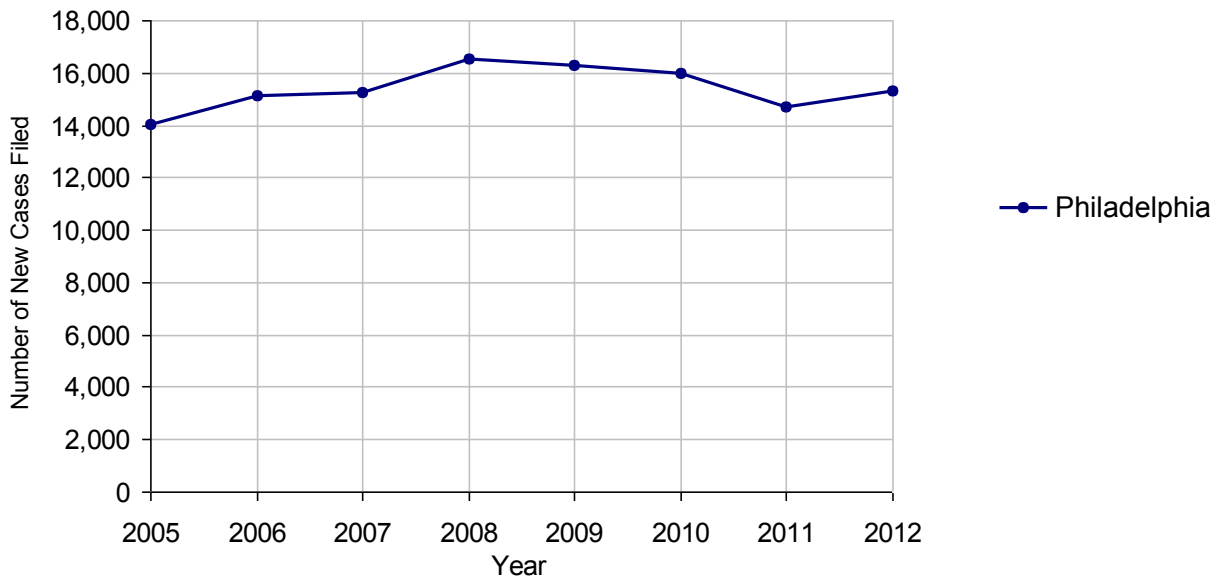

**Criminal New Cases Filed, 2005-2012**

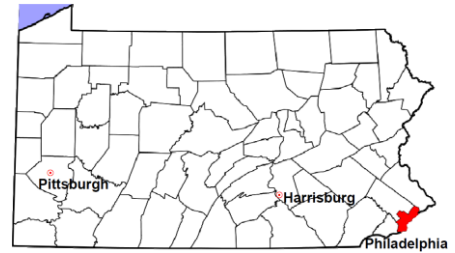

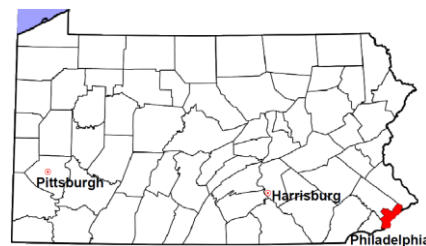

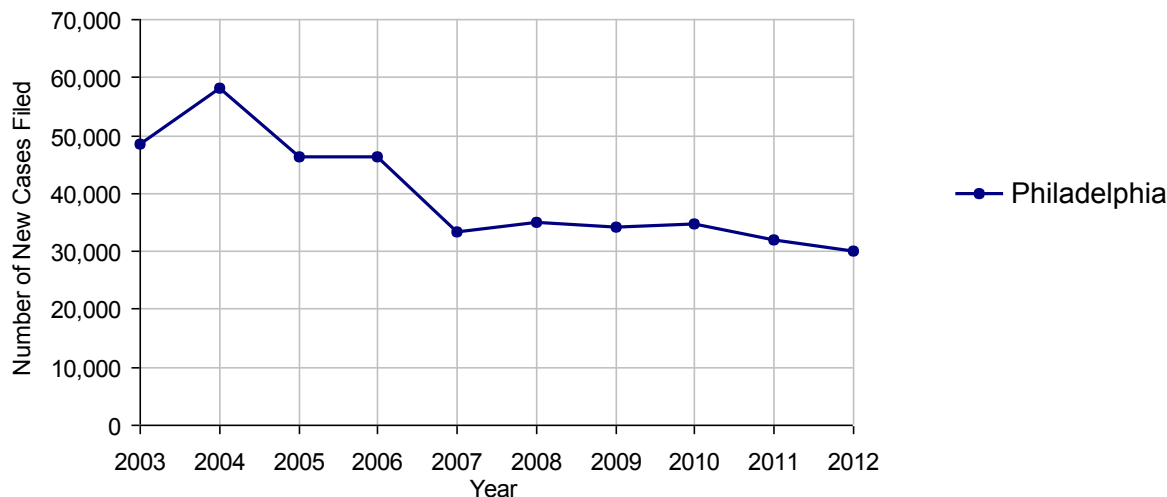

Docketed Cases, 2003-2012



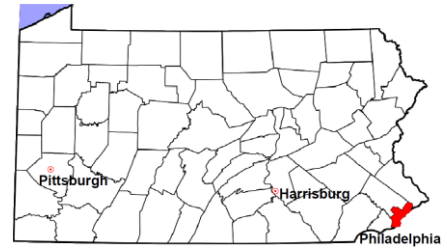

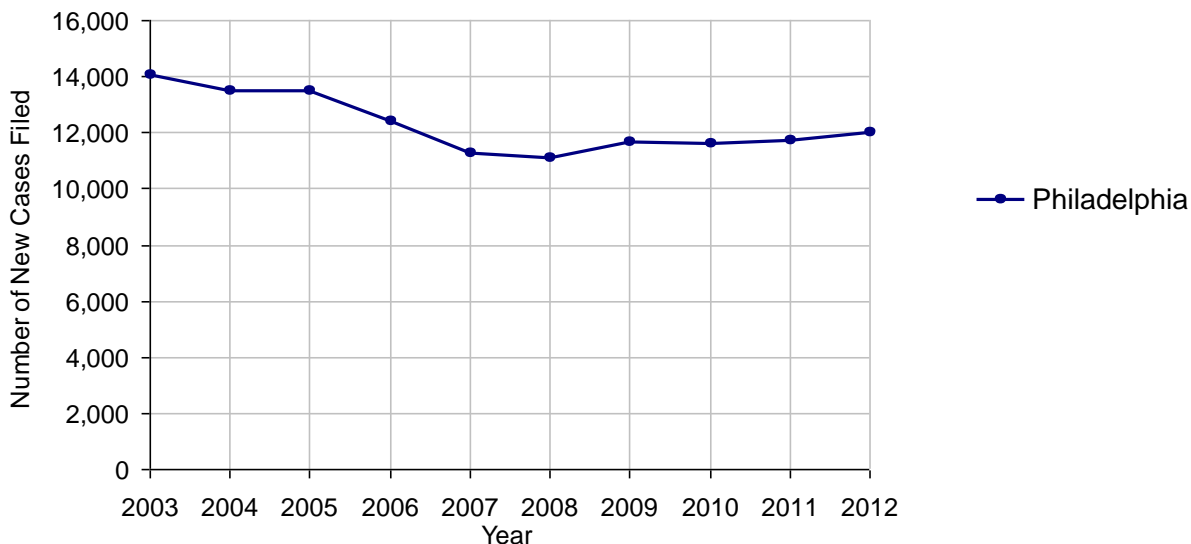

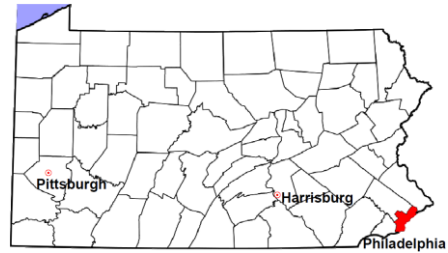

**PFA New Cases Filed, 2003-2012**



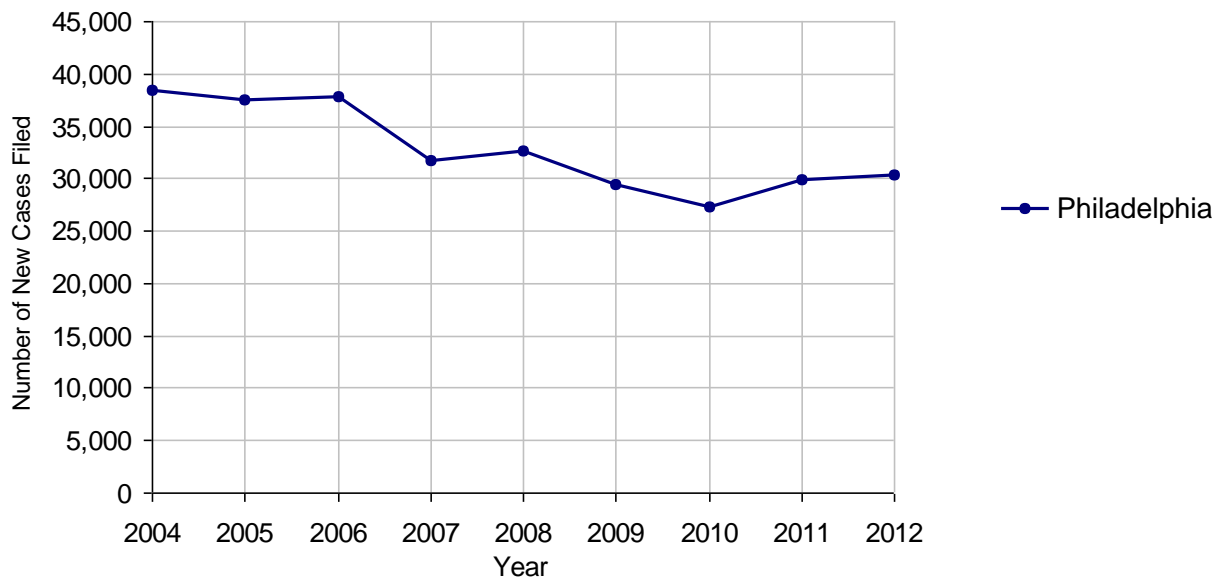

Custody/Partial Custody/Visitation New Cases Filed, 2003-2012

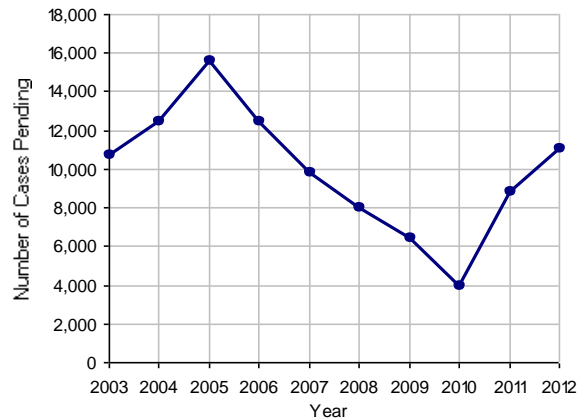


Clearance Rate, 2003-2012



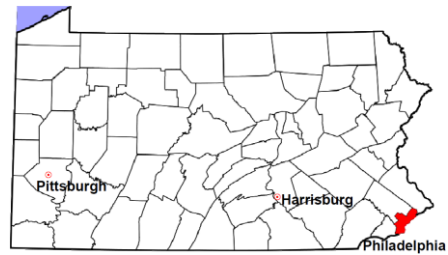

Cases Pending at the End of Year, 2003-2012



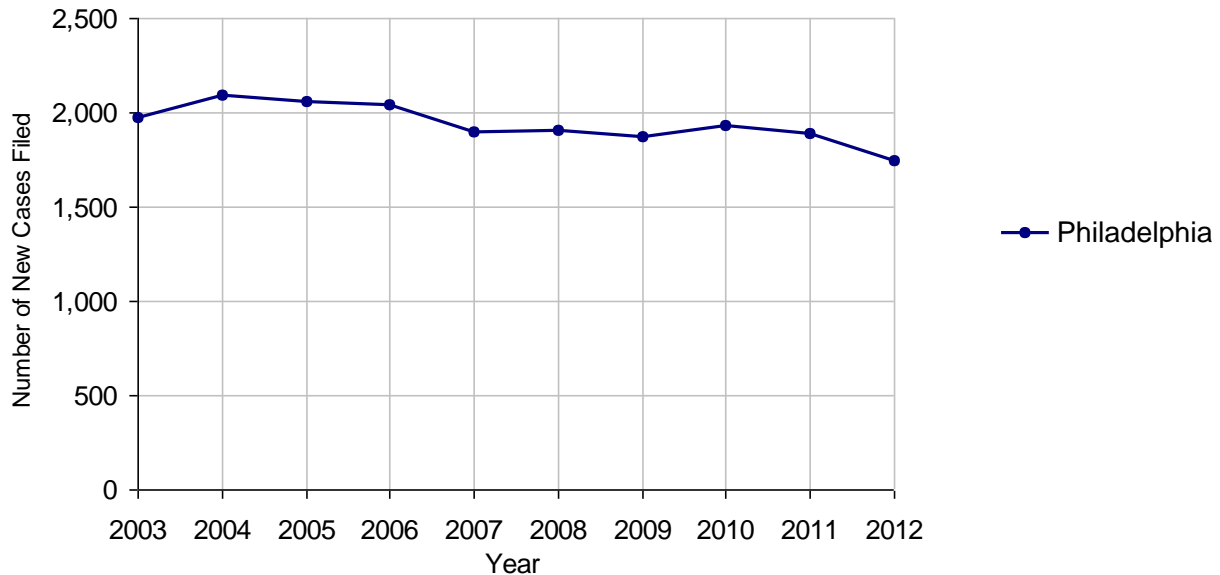

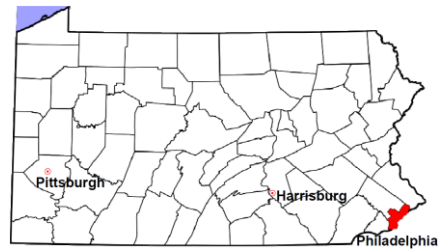
**Divorce New Cases Filed, 2003-2012**

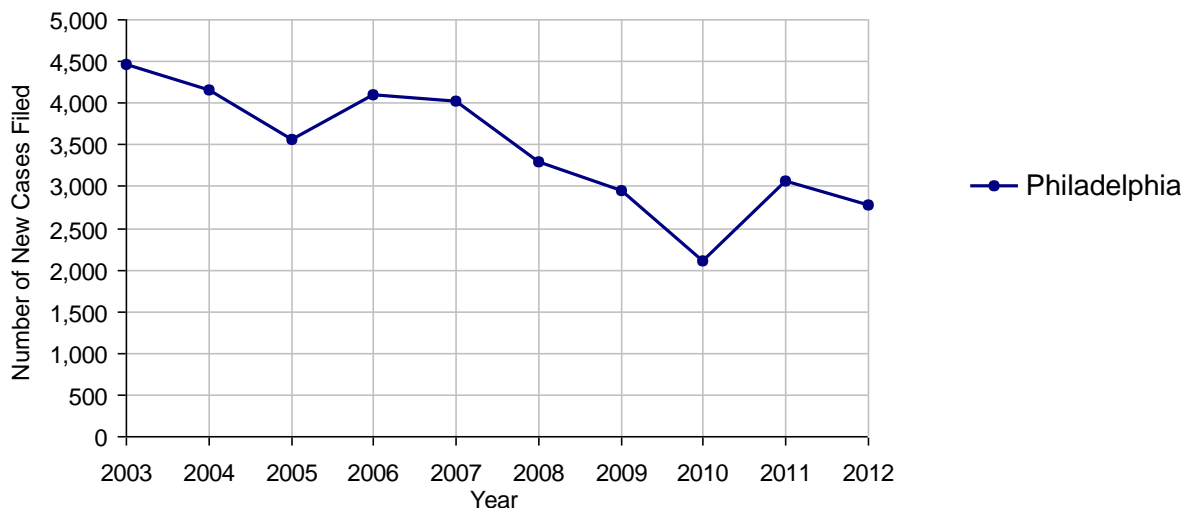

Abuse/Neglect and Status Offenses New Cases Filed, 2003-2012



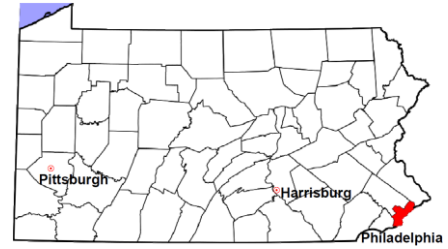

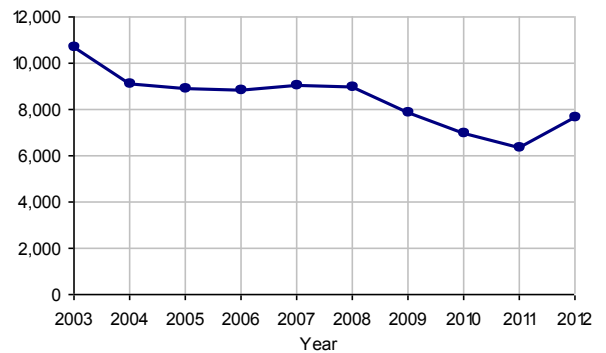

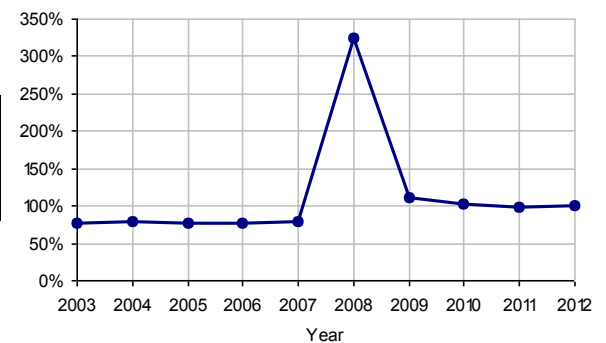

Juvenile Delinquency New Cases Filed, 2003-2012

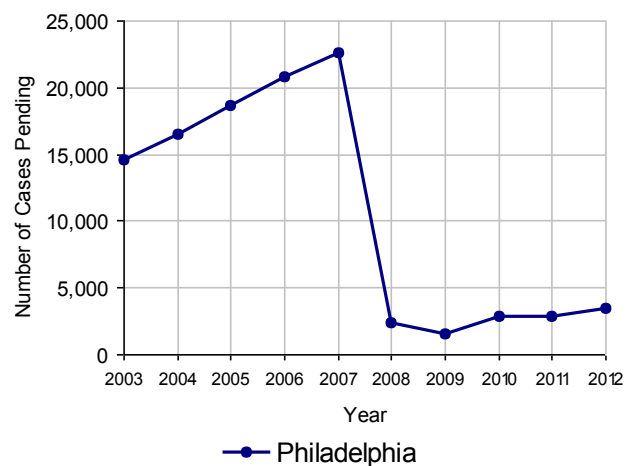


Clearance Rate, 2003-2012



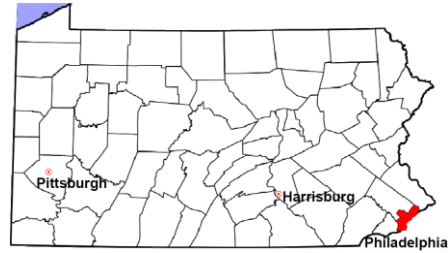

Cases Pending at the End of Year, 2003-2012



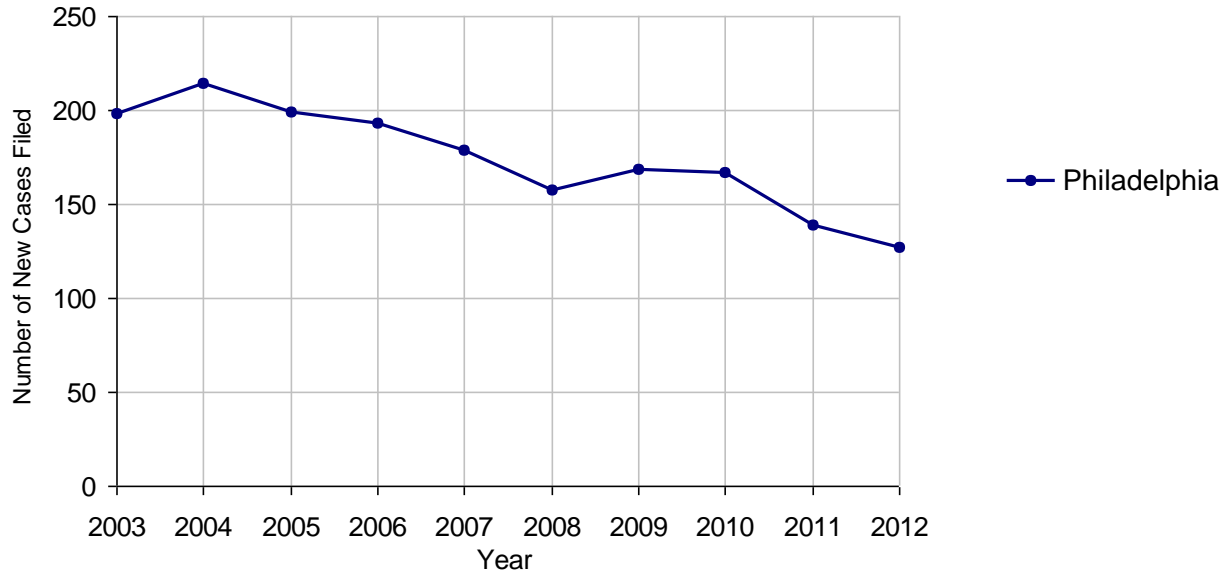

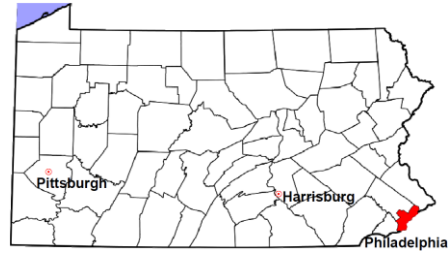

**Accounts New Cases Filed, 2003-2012**



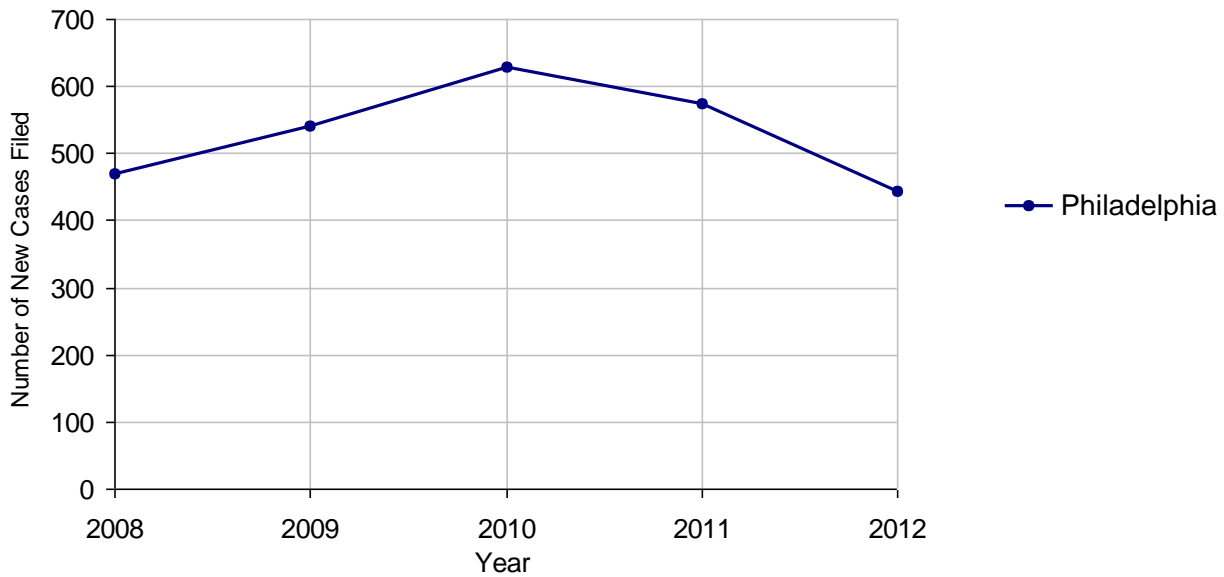

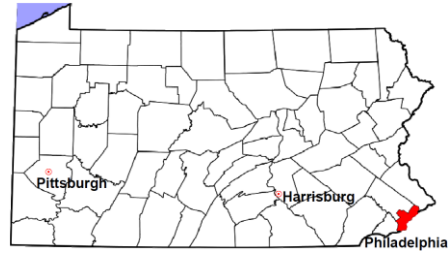
**Adoptions New Cases Filed, 2008-2012**

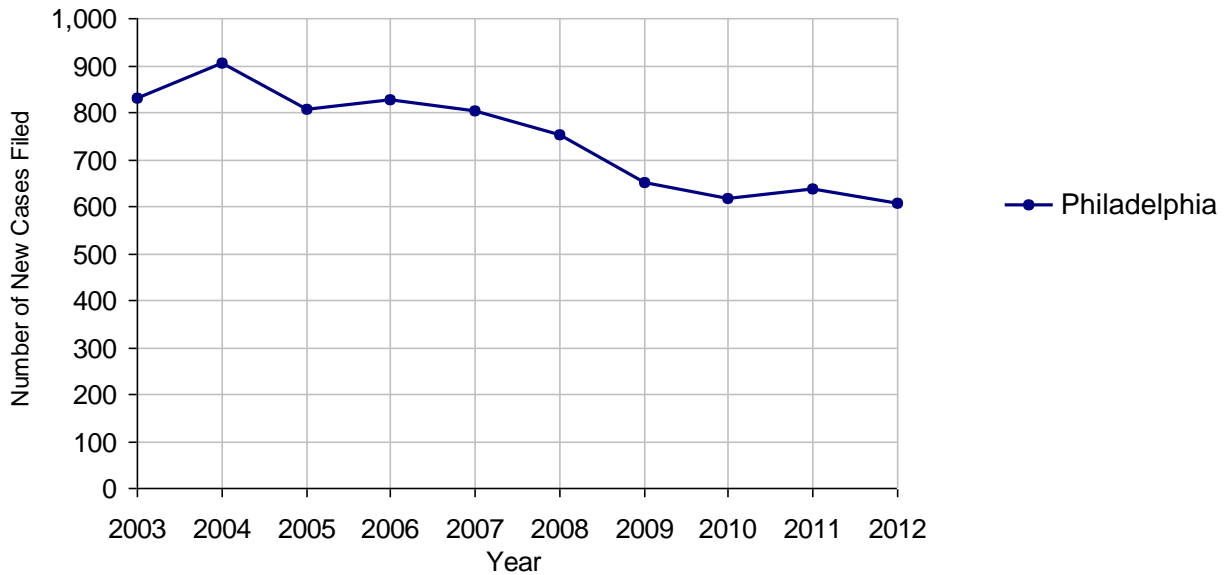

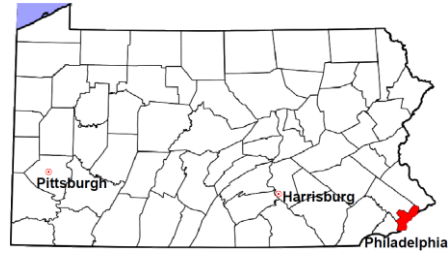

Relinquishments/Terminations New Cases Filed, 2003-2012



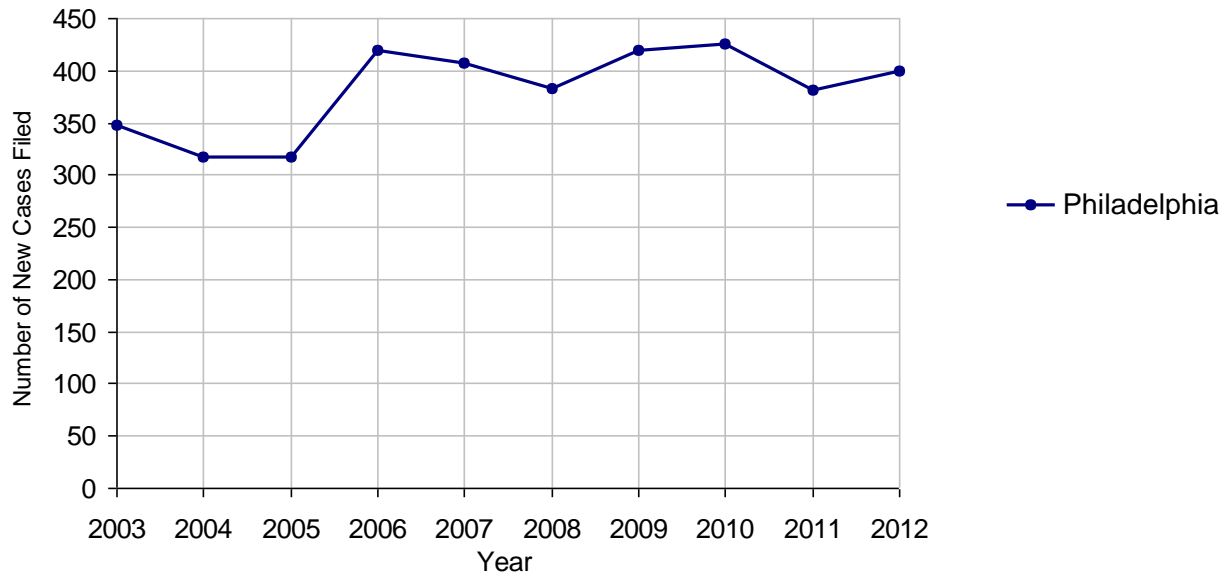

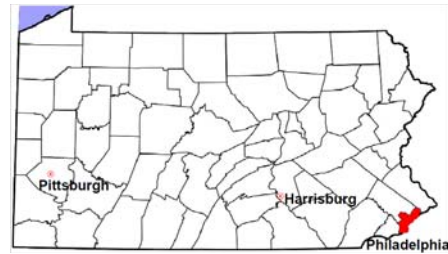

In mid-2011, AOPC began utilizing the National Center for State Courts' Jury Managers' Toolbox for collecting jury data. In 2012, the counties began providing additional jury data which included information about the summoning practices in the counties. With this additional data, we can now see not only how many citizens come to our courthouses every day in anticipation of serving on a jury, but the number of citizens actually summonsed and the number of those summonsed who are exempt, excused or disqualified from service. With this wider view of the jury process, we can determine the efficiency with which our courts operate, and with the assistance of the Jury Managers' Toolbox find guidance in streamlining the jury summonsing practices.
