

Affidavit of Consent of Defendant

Form 5b

If the Defendant agrees to the entry of a divorce, he or she may sign an Affidavit of Consent after waiting 90 days from the date the complaint was served.

Form 5b – Affidavit of Consent Defendant

The numbers on these instructions correspond with the numbers in the boxes on the form. Use the form with the boxes to guide you through filling out the blank form.

Box 1: Print the name of the county you are filing in exactly as you wrote it on Form 1.

Box 2: Print the name of the Plaintiff exactly as it appears on Form 1.

Box 3: Print the docket number of your case, the same way it was written by the Prothonotary's Office at the time of filing.

Box 4: Print the name of the Defendant exactly as it appears on Form 1.

Box 5: Print the date the complaint (Form 1) was filed in the Office of the Prothonotary.

Box 6: The Defendant, your spouse, must write the date he or she is signing.

Box 7: The Defendant, your spouse must sign this form if he or she agrees to the entry of the divorce decree.

This form must be filed with the Prothonotary / Clerk within thirty (30) days of the day it is signed.
