

Waiver of Notice for Defendant

When the Defendant signs the Affidavit of Consent (Form 2) he may also agree to give up his right to receive notice of your request for a divorce decree.

Form 6b – Waiver of Notice for Defendant

The numbers on these instructions correspond with the numbers in the boxes on the form. Use the form with the boxes to guide you through filling out the blank form.

Box 1: Print the name of the county in which you filed exactly as you wrote it on other forms.

Box 2: Print the name of the Plaintiff exactly as it appears on Form 1.

Box 3: Print the docket number that the Prothonotary's Office wrote on Form 1 at the time of filing.

Box 4: Print the name of the Defendant exactly as it appears on Form 1.

Box 5: Your spouse must write the date if he or she does not want further notice of your request for a divorce decree.

Box 6: Your spouse must sign this form if he or she does not want further notice of your request for a divorce decree.

If your spouse signs this form, it must be filed with the Prothonotary / Clerk along with the Affidavit of Consent of Defendant.

WAIVER OF NOTICE OF INTENTION TO REQUEST ENTRY OF A DIVORCE DECREE UNDER § 3301(c) AND § 3301(d) OF THE DIVORCE CODE – DEFENDANT

1. I consent to the entry of a final decree of divorce without notice.
2. I understand that I may lose rights concerning alimony, division of property, lawyer's fees or expenses if I do not claim them before a divorce is granted.
3. I understand that I will not be divorced until a divorce decree is entered by the Court and that a copy of the decree will be sent to me immediately after it is filed with the prothonotary.
