

# **Waiver of Notice for Plaintiff**

## **Form 6a**

When you sign the Affidavit of Consent (Form 2) you may also agree to give up your right to receive notice of a request for a divorce decree.

## **Form 6a – Waiver of Notice for Plaintiff**

*The numbers on these instructions correspond with the numbers in the boxes on the form. Use the form with the boxes to guide you through filling out the blank form.*

Box 1: Print the name of the county in which you filed exactly as you wrote it on other forms.

Box 2: Print the name of the Plaintiff exactly as it appears on Form 1.

Box 3: Print the docket number that the Prothonotary's Office wrote on Form 1 at the time of filing.

Box 4: Print the name of the Defendant exactly as it appears on Form 1.

Box 5: Write the date you sign the form.

Box 6: Sign this form if you do not want further notice of a request for a divorce decree.

**File this form with the Prothonotary / Clerk along with the Affidavit of Consent of Plaintiff.**

**WAIVER OF NOTICE OF INTENTION TO REQUEST ENTRY OF A DIVORCE DECREE UNDER § 3301(c) AND § 3301(d) OF THE DIVORCE CODE – PLAINTIFF**

1. I consent to the entry of a final decree of divorce without notice.
2. I understand that I may lose rights concerning alimony, division of property, lawyer's fees or expenses if I do not claim them before a divorce is granted.
3. I understand that I will not be divorced until a divorce decree is entered by the Court and that a copy of the decree will be sent to me immediately after it is filed with the prothonotary.
