
MOTION OF THE RESPONDENT, THOMASINE TYNES,  
TO STAY THE REMOVAL ORDER OF DECEMBER 16, 2016  
AND TO ALLOW MEDICAL BENEFITS TO CONTINUE PENDING THE APPEAL

The Respondent, Thomasine Tynes, by and through her counsel, Samuel C. Stretton, Esquire, respectfully requests this Honorable Court stay the removal Order dated December 16, 2016 and allow medical benefits to continue pending the appeal for the following reasons:

1. On December 16, 2016, the Court of Judicial Discipline, by Order removed Thomasine Tynes.
2. Mr. Stretton has filed an appeal to the Pennsylvania Supreme Court on the sanction issue.
