RESIGNATION UNDER Pa.R.D.E. 215

Michael Robert Shapiro hereby tenders his unconditional resignation from the practice of law in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in conformity with Rule 215, Pa.R.D.E. ("Enforcement Rules"), and further states as follows:

 He is an attorney admitted in the Commonwealth of Pernsylvania, having been admitted to the bar on January 12, 2006. His attorney registration number is 200837.

2. He is currently on suspended status, having been temporarily suspended from the practice of law by an Order of the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania dated February 19, 2019. A true and correct copy of the Order is attached as "Exhibit A."

3. He desires to submit his resignation as a member of said bar.

4. His resignation is freely and voluntarily rendered; he is not being subjected to coercion or duress; and he is

fully aware of the implications of submitting this resignation.

5. He is aware that there is presently pending an investigation into allegations that he has been guilty of misconduct, based upon his conviction of criminal charges as more fully set forth in the Information at CP-09-CR-0001661-2019, a true and correct copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as "Exhibit B."

6. On January 13, 2020, he pled guilty and was convicted in the Court of Common Pleas of Bucks County, Pennsylvania, of the criminal offenses set forth in "Exhibit B."

7. He submits the within resignation because the said convictions stand as a <u>per se</u> ground for discipline under Enforcement Pules 214(e) and 203(b)(1), and because he is guilty of the crimes.

8. He submits the within resignation because he knows that if disciplinary charges were predicated upon the convictions, he could not successfully defend against them.

9. He is fully aware that submission of this Resignation Statement is irrevocable and that he can only apply for reinstatement to the practice of law pursuant to the provisions of Enforcement Rule 218(b) and (c).

10. He is aware that pursuant to Enforcement Rule 215(c), the fact that he has tendered this resignation shall become a matter of public record immediately upon delivery of the resignation statement to Disciplinary Counsel or the Board.

11. Upon entry of the order disbarring him on consent, he will promptly comply with the notice, withdrawal, resignation, trust accounting, and cease-and-desist provisions of subdivisions (a), (b), (c) and (d) of Enforcement Rule 217.

12. After entry of the order disbarring him on consent, he will file a verified statement of compliance as required by Enforcement Rule 217(e)(1).

13. He is aware that the waiting period for eligibility to apply for reinstatement to the practice of law under Enforcement Rule 218(b) shall not begin until he files the verified statement of compliance, and if the order of disbarment contains a provision that makes the disbarment retroactive to an earlier date, then the waiting period will be deemed to have begun on that earlier date.

14. He acknowledges that he is fully aware of his right to consult and employ counsel to represent him in the instant proceeding. He has retained, consulted with and acted upon the advice of counsel in connection with his decision to execute the within resignation.

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15. He requests that his disbarment be made retroactive to February 19, 2019, the date of the Order of temporary suspension. He has been advised that the Office of Disciplinary Counsel does not oppose his request. He understands that the decision to grant his request lies solely within the discretion of the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania.

It is understood that the statements made herein are subject to the penalties of 18 Pa.C.S., Section 4904 (relating to unsworn falsification to authorities).
