**CONCURRING OPINION**

**MR. JUSTICE EAKIN**

**DECIDED: May 28, 2014**

As does the Chief Justice, I join the majority with the exception of footnote 12, and find no need to distinguish my position in Commonwealth v. Walker, \_\_ A.3d \_\_ (Pa. 2014), from the present case. As in that case, I find neither need nor salience in allowing opinion testimony about the assessment or valuation of ordinary evidence, which is the peculiar responsibility of the jury.
