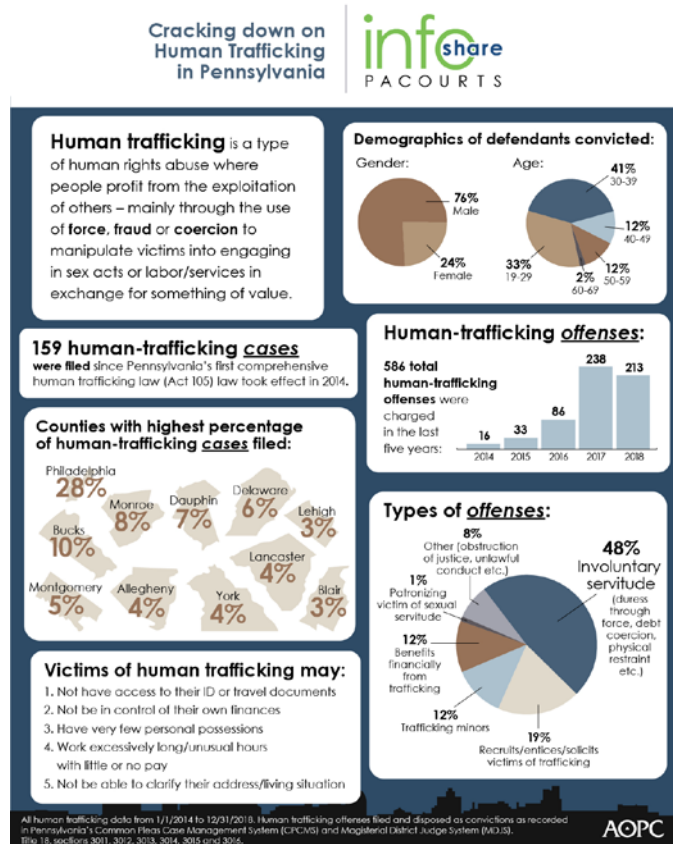

Cracking Down on Human Trafficking in Pennsylvania

HARRISBURG — In the first five years since Pennsylvania’s first comprehensive human-trafficking law (Act 105) took effect in 2014, **586 human-trafficking offenses** were charged.
