RULE 1187. AUTHORITY OF MASTER

- A. No authority. A master shall not have the authority to:
 - 1) preside over:
 - a) adjudicatory and dispositional hearings;
 - **[c]b)** any hearing in which any party seeks to establish a permanency goal of adoption or change the permanency goal to adoption;
 - [a]c) termination of parental rights hearings; and

[b]d) adoptions;

- enter orders for emergency or protective custody pursuant to Rules 1200 and 1210;
- 3) issue warrants; and
- 4) issue contempt orders.
