## Proposed Amendments to Pa.R.C.P. Nos. 1930.2, 1930.4, and 1930.5

## PUBLICATION REPORT

The Committee is proposing the amendments of Pa.R.C.P. Nos. 1930.2, 1930.4, and 1930.5. Due to the enactment of 42 Pa.C.S. §§62A01 - 62A20, providing for the protection of victims of sexual violence and intimidation, and the Supreme Court adopting Chapter 1950 of the Pennsylvania Rules of Civil Procedure, ancillary rules dealing with post-trial relief, service of process, and discovery in Domestic Relations matters in the 1930 series of rules required amendment to incorporate the new legislation and rules into the existing rules. In addition, format, grammar, and stylistic changes were made to clarify the rules, provide for easier readability and ensure the rules were unambiguous.
