## RESPONDENTS' APPLICATION TO SUBSTITUTE SUCCESSOR PURSUANT TO PENNSYLVANIA RULE OF CIVIL PROCEDURE 2352

Respondents, the Acting Secretary of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and Director of the Bureau of Elections and Notaries, submit this Application to Substitute Successor Pursuant to Pennsylvania Rule of Civil Procedure 2352 on behalf of Leigh M. Chapman, Acting Secretary of the Commonwealth of

Pennsylvania. In support of the Application, Respondents state the following material facts:

- 1. On December 17, 2021, two sets of Petitioners initiated the above-captioned actions: *Carter, et al. v. Degraffenreid, et al.*, No. 464 M.D. 2021 (*Carter II*), and *Gressman, et al. v. Degraffenreid, et al.*, No. 465 M.D. 2021 (*Gressman*).
- 2. At the time *Carter II* and *Gressman* were initiated, Veronica Degraffenreid was the Acting Secretary of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Former Acting Secretary Degraffenreid was named as a Respondent in each of the above-captioned actions.
- 3. The Court consolidated *Carter II* and *Gressman* on December 20, 2021.
- 4. On January 8, 2022, Leigh M. Chapman was appointed Acting Secretary of the Commonwealth.
- 5. Under Pennsylvania Rule of Civil Procedure 2352, a "successor may become a party to a pending action by filing of record a statement of the material facts on which the right to substitution is based." Pa. R. Civ. P. 2352(a).
- 6. The Pennsylvania Rules of Civil Procedure define a "successor" as "anyone who by operation of law, election or appointment has succeeded to the interest or office of a party to an action." Pa. R. Civ. P. 2351.

7. By operation of appointment, Acting Secretary of the Commonwealth Chapman is a "successor" to former Acting Secretary of the Commonwealth Degraffenreid in the above-captioned actions, pursuant to Rules 2351 and 2352.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Respondents respectfully request that the Court grant the Application to Substitute Successor Pursuant to Pennsylvania Rule of Civil Procedure 2352 and substitute Acting Secretary of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Leigh M. Chapman for former Acting Secretary of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Veronica Degraffenreid in the above-captioned actions.
