DECORUM ORDER

NOW, October 15, 2021, regarding the hearing on the Application for Leave to Intervene filed by the Democratic National Committee and the

Pennsylvania Democratic Party scheduled for October 22, 2021, at 9:30 a.m., in Courtroom 3001, Third Floor, Pennsylvania Judicial Center, 601 Commonwealth Avenue, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, the court hereby **ORDERS** as follows:

1. To reduce the risk of transmission of the COVID-19 virus, all persons participating in or observing the proceedings shall adhere to the posted COVID-19 precautions and procedures while in the Pennsylvania Judicial Center, including, but not limited to, the Commonwealth Court's COVID-19 Protocols for In-Person Single-Judge Proceedings posted September 10, 2021, at pacourts.us/courts/commonwealth-court.

2. No person who (i) has returned from international travel in the last 14 days, (ii) demonstrates symptoms of respiratory illness or fever, or (iii) has had contact with a person who has been diagnosed with, or is under investigation for, COVID-19 may attend as counsel, a party, witness, credentialed member of the media, or public observer.
