

To All Citizens of Jefferson County (The 54th Judicial District of Pennsylvania):


Every ten (10) years after the U.S. Census is completed, the President Judge of each Judicial District of Pennsylvania is challenged to review the lines of their respective Magisterial Judicial Districts.

Although this time to evaluate coincides with a population count, the court is charged with looking at the average caseloads of each district over the last ten (10) years.

After review of the population and caseloads, the current lines of our district continue to meet the criteria set forth by the Pennsylvania Supreme Court; as such, no changes will be made to the current configuration of the Magisterial District Judge lines.
