MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT JUSTICE MICHAEL R. MUTH'S MOTION IN LIMINE TO PRECLUDE THE DEPOSITION TRANSCRIPT

Magisterial District Justice Michael R. Muth, by and through his undersigned counsel, Lamb McErlane PC, hereby files this Motion in Limine in anticipation of the hearing scheduled in the above referenced matter.

- 1. On or about February 24, 2017, MDJ Muth submitted to a deposition in the course of the discovery phase of this matter.
- 2. The Judicial Conduct Board ("JCB") indicated it will seek to introduce the entire transcript ("Transcript") of MDJ Muth's deposition at time of the hearing.
- 3. Portions of the Transcript contain information that is well outside of the parameters of the Complaint the JCB filed.
- 4. In the Complaint, the JCB alleges 1) MDJ Muth allegedly viewed and displayed pornographic images in court offices during business hours; and 2) MDJ Muth allegedly utilized court staff and equipment for non-court related tasks. *See Complaint dated July 5*, 2017.

- 5. Any information contained in the Transcript that is outside the parameters of the allegations contained in the Complaint is irrelevant to the proceedings.
- 6. Pursuant to Pennsylvania Rule of Evidence 402, "[e]vidence that is not relevant is not admissible." It is well-settled in Pennsylvania that "[e]vidence which tends to establish some fact material to the case, or which tends to make a fact at issue more or less probable, is relevant." Pa. R.E. 401; *Commonwealth v. Scott*, 389 A.2d 79, 82 (Pa. 1978).
- 7. Any information contained in the Transcript that does not relate to whether certain court personnel viewed the photographs at issue or whether MDJ Muth used court personnel and equipment for non-court related tasks is irrelevant and contains no probative value.
- 8. All other topics from the Transcript unrelated to the allegations in the Complaint will not make the allegations in the Complaint more or less probable.
- 9. Any information contained in the Transcript that does not relate to the allegations in the Complaint must be precluded at the hearing of this matter. As such, the JCB should be precluded from offering the Transcript in its entirety and should be limited to offering only those portions of the Transcript that are relevant to the issues in the Complaint.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth herein, Magisterial District Judge Michael R. Muth requests that the JCB be precluded from introducing and offering the Deposition Transcript of MDJ Muth in its entirety and request that the JCB be limited to introducing those portions of the Transcript that relate to the allegations in the Complaint.
