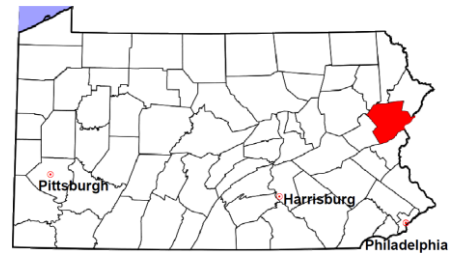

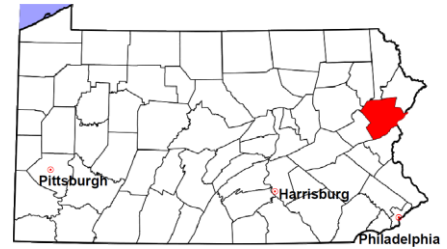
Docketed Cases, 2003-2012

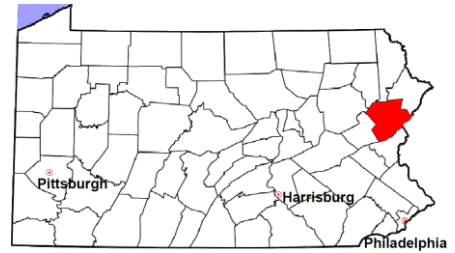

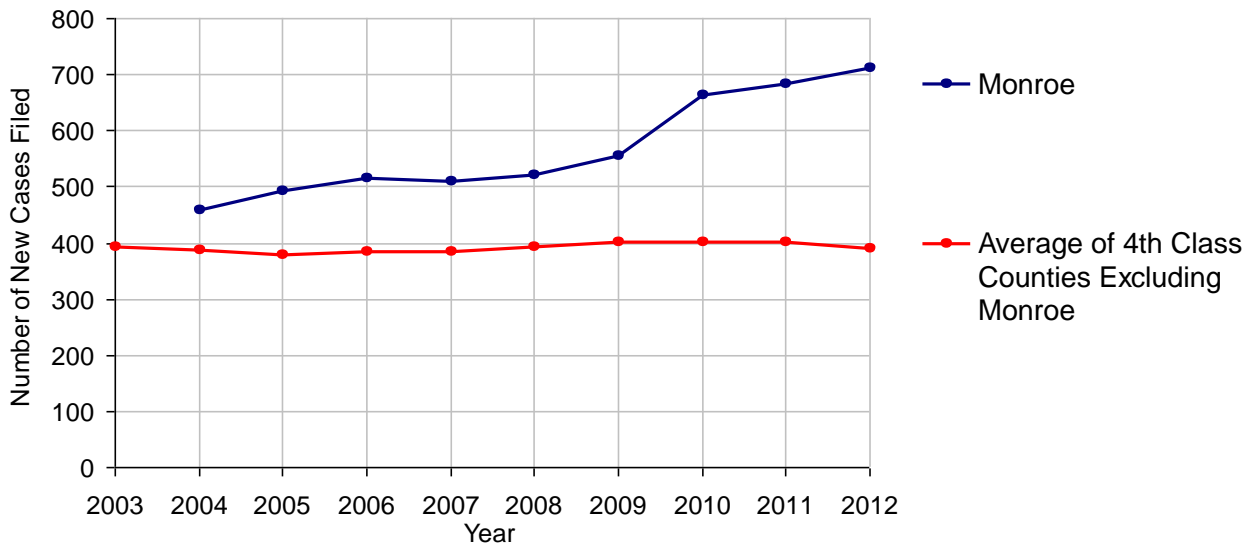

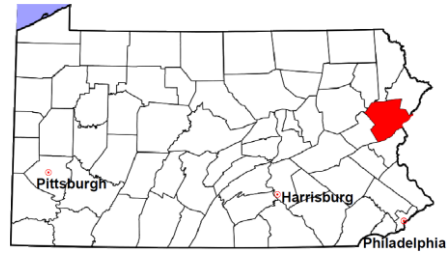
**PFA New Cases Filed, 2003-2012**

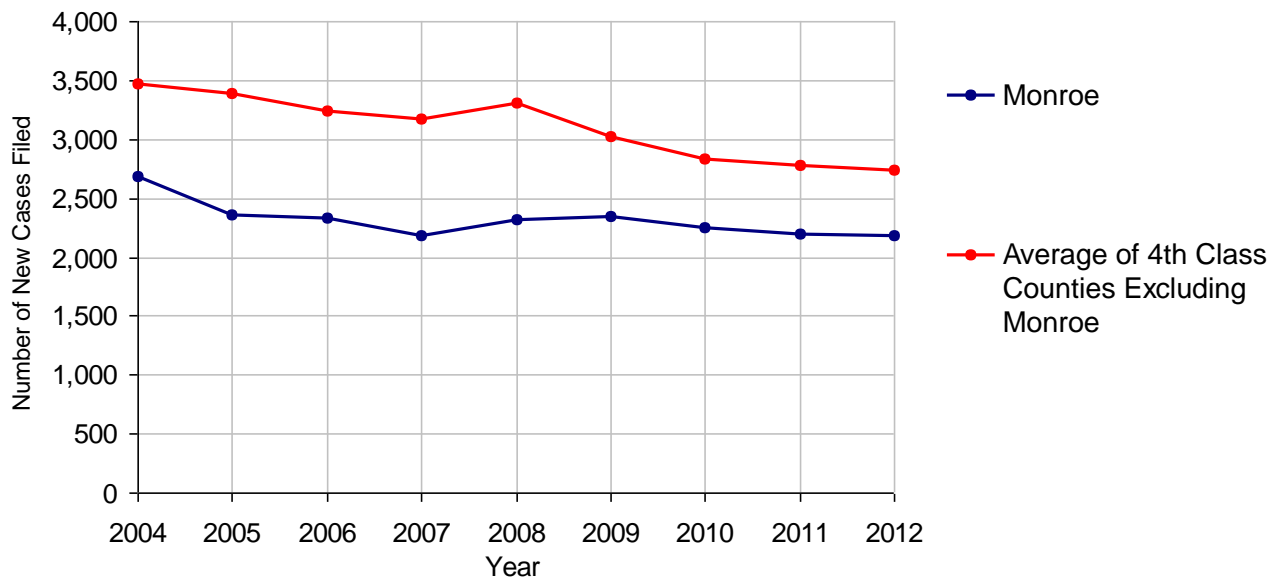

**Spousal & Child Support New Cases Filed, 2004-2012**

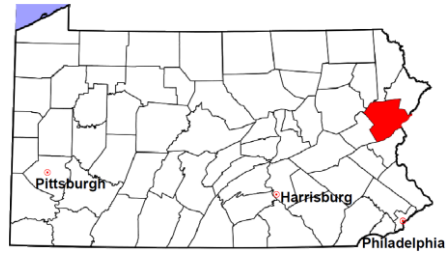

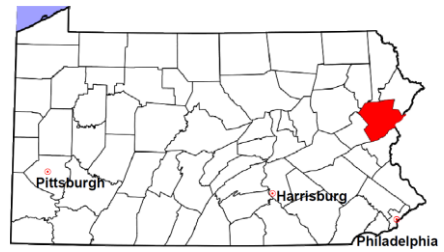
**Divorce New Cases Filed, 2003-2012**

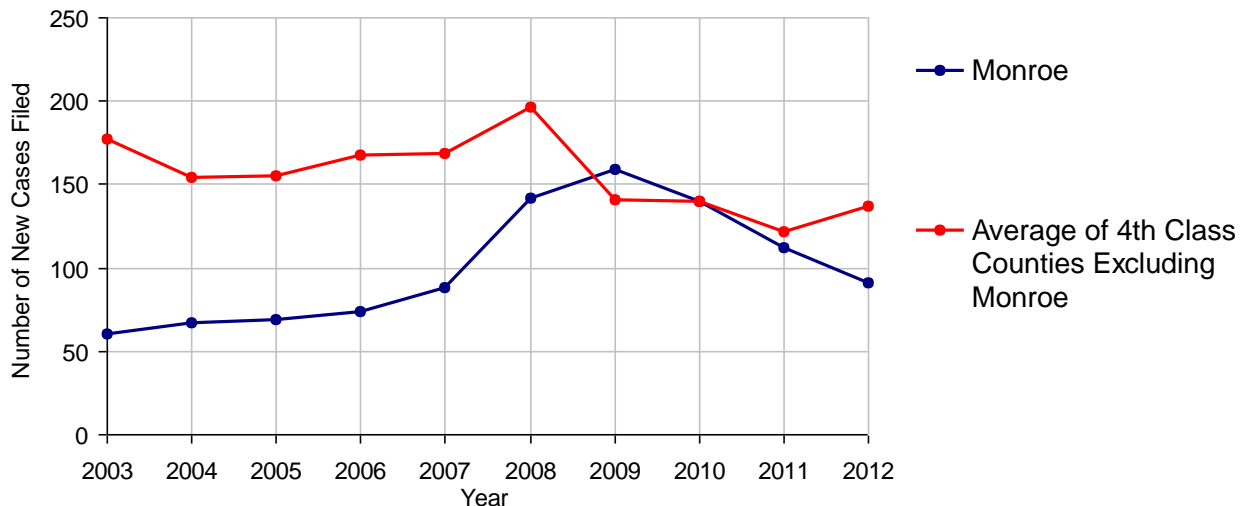

Abuse/Neglect and Status Offenses New Cases Filed, 2003-2012



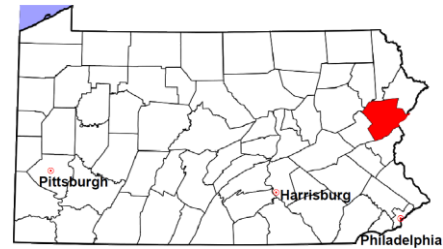

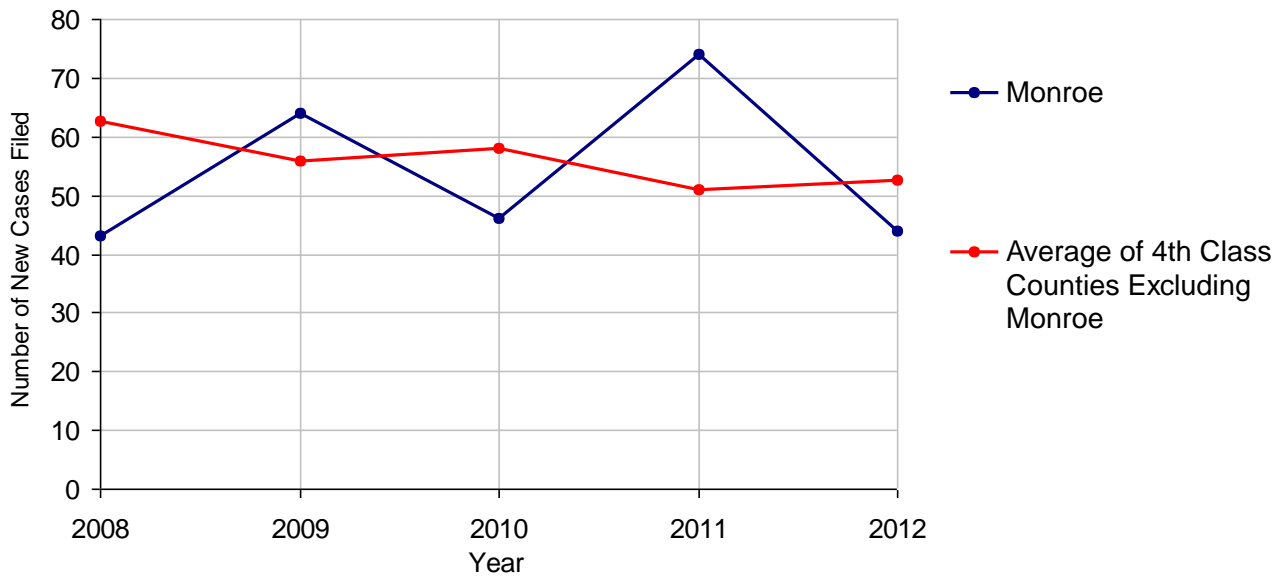

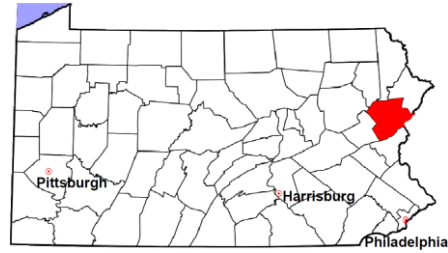
Adoptions New Cases Filed, 2008-2012

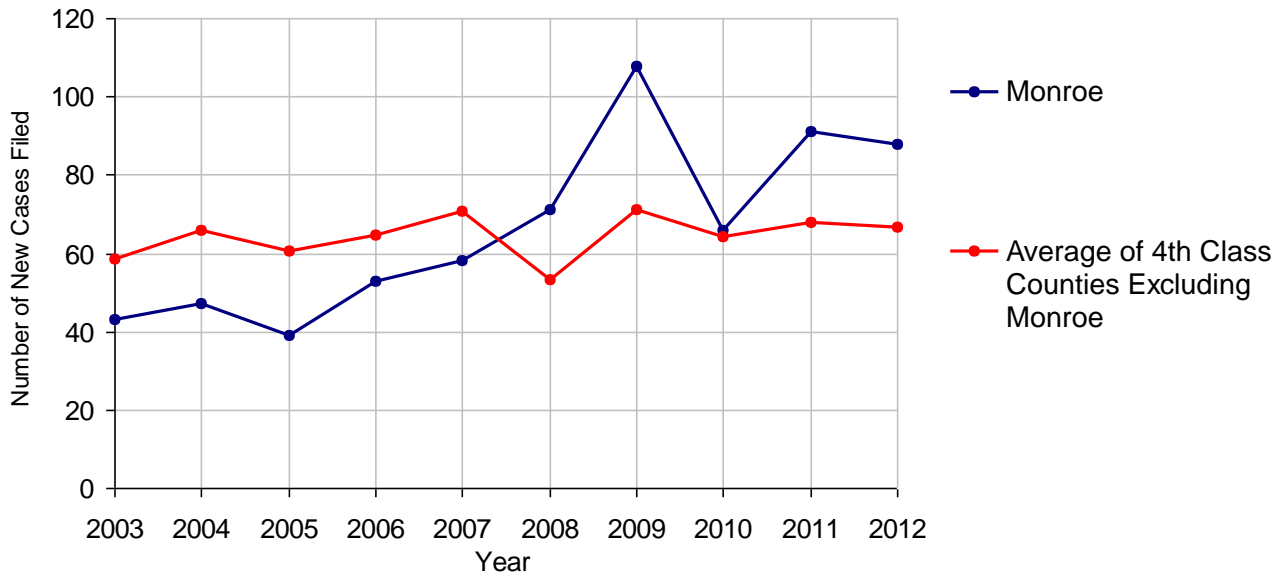

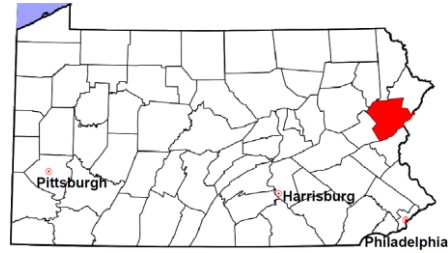

Relinquishments/Terminations New Cases Filed, 2003-2012



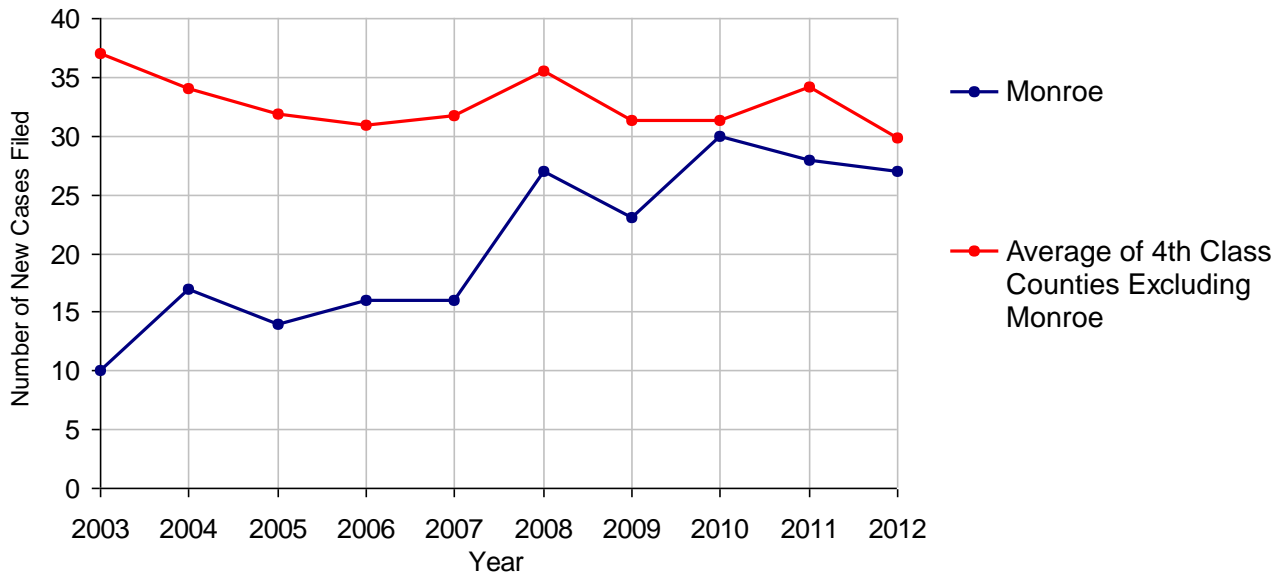

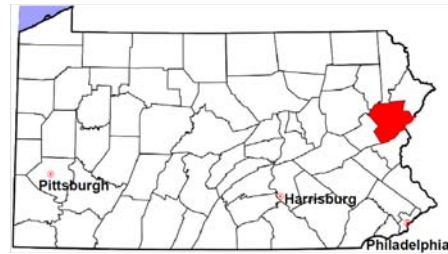

In mid-2011, AOPC began utilizing the National Center for State Courts' Jury Managers' Toolbox for collecting jury data. In 2012, the counties began providing additional jury data which included information about the summoning practices in the counties. With this additional data, we can now see not only how many citizens come to our courthouses every day in anticipation of serving on a jury, but the number of citizens actually summonsed and the number of those summonsed who are exempt, excused or disqualified from service. With this wider view of the jury process, we can determine the efficiency with which our courts operate, and with the assistance of the Jury Managers' Toolbox find guidance in streamlining the jury summoning practices.
