SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

April 24, 2020: Upon consideration of current circumstances relating to the COVID-19 (coronavirus) pandemic, the state of emergency declared by the Governor of Pennsylvania, the Orders of the Pennsylvania Supreme Court, and guidance from the Pennsylvania Department of Health:

The Superior Court will commence hearing oral arguments by telephone conference on April 30 and May 1, 2020, in a limited number of cases previously ordered to be submitted on brief.
