**Procedures for Blair County Custody Office March 16- April 14, 2020**


**1. Interpretation of custody schedule for "off school" time due to corona virus**

It shall be the policy of this Court that custody schedules shall be followed consistent with the regular school schedule as outline by the respective school districts at the beginning of the school year. The normal custody schedules will not be disrupted by the current shutdown of schools related to Coronavirus. This action is taken to provide consistency for the parties and avoid numerous Petitions filed with the Court requiring individuals to appear in court for hearings.

**2. Matters Continued**

All matters in custody have been continued until at least April 3, 2020 with the exception of emergency petitions for child custody.
