ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

And now, this 19th day of March, 2020, in consideration of the Pennsylvania Supreme Court Order issued March 18, 2020 declaring a statewide judicial emergency until April 3, 2020 as a protective measure to reduce exposure to COVID-19, and our Administrative Order of Court declaring same on March 17, 2020, it is hereby ORDERED and DECREED that our Administrative Order issued on March 17, 2020 is AMENDED to provide that the Court of Common Pleas of the 9th Judicial District, Cumberland County, and all Magisterial District Judge Offices are CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC until and including April 3, 2020, except for emergency proceedings as provided for in our March 17, 2020 Order, and as provided for in the Supreme Court Order issued March 18, 2018, with such emergency proceedings included therein incorporated here by reference, and further providing for emergency Mental Health Review Hearings pursuant to Sections 303 and 304.

This order shall remain in effect until April 3, 2020, subject to additional orders.
