

AND NOW, **March 25, 2020**, it is here ORDERED and DECREED that unless otherwise modified by the Court, custody orders entered before the Declaration of Judicial Emergency on March 17, 2020, **remain in effect**, and are unaffected by any shelter-in-place or comparable order that has been or may be issued, with due consideration for the safety of the child or children. Furthermore, all custody orders are to be construed in conformity with school schedules as they existed prior to mandated COVID-19 school closings and cancelations.
