
MAY CRIMINAL TRIAL TERM

AND NOW, **April 2, 2020**, in accordance with the Order of the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania declaring a general, statewide, judicial emergency, and the Second Supplemental Order thereto, *see* Nos. 531 and 532 Judicial Administrative Docket (March 16, 2020, and April 1, 2020), and pursuant to this Court's Declaration of Judicial Emergency, *see* Case No. 27 WM 2020, the following is hereby ORDERED:

1. The May Term of Criminal Court is CANCELLED;
2. All cases currently listed for the May Term of Criminal Court are CONTINUED to the June Term of Criminal Court;
3. The Call of the Trial List for the May Term of Criminal Court scheduled for April 27, 2020, is CANCELLED;
4. The Call of the Trial List for all cases listed for the May Term of Criminal Court, as well as the June Term of Criminal Court, will be held on May 26, 2020, at 8:45 a.m., in Courtroom No. 1 of the Crawford County Judicial Center, Meadville, Pa.;

5. Any delay in the time for a trial that will be continued pursuant to this Order shall be attributable to the judiciary and excluded from the computation of time under Pennsylvania Rule of Criminal Procedure 600(C), which in any event, has been suspended through at least April 30, 2020, by order of the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania.
